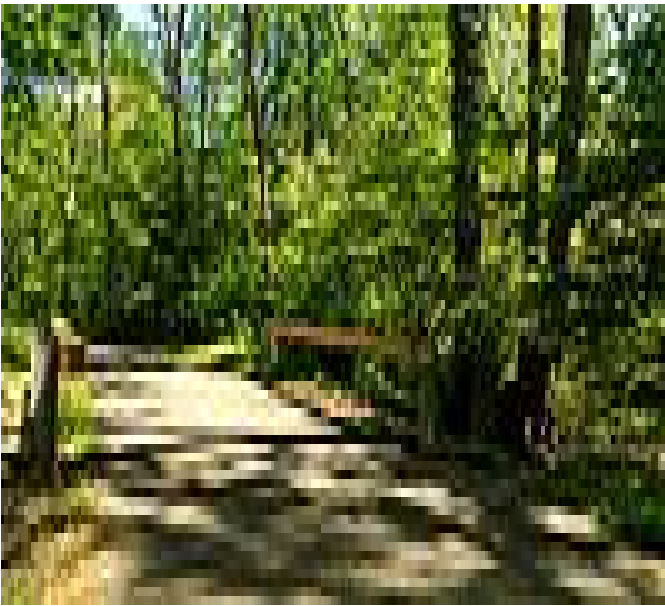

The trail exists in 2 sections: the northern segment begins in the Fairland Recreational Park and winds south, eventually ending at Gunpowder Road, across I-95. The southern segment is in Little Paint Branch Park and connects to the Beltsville Community Center. The trail is part of the Anacostia Tributary Trail System. An 2.1-mile [extension](#) is currently under construction to connect this trail to the [Paint Branch Trail](#) across the I-95/I-495 exchange.

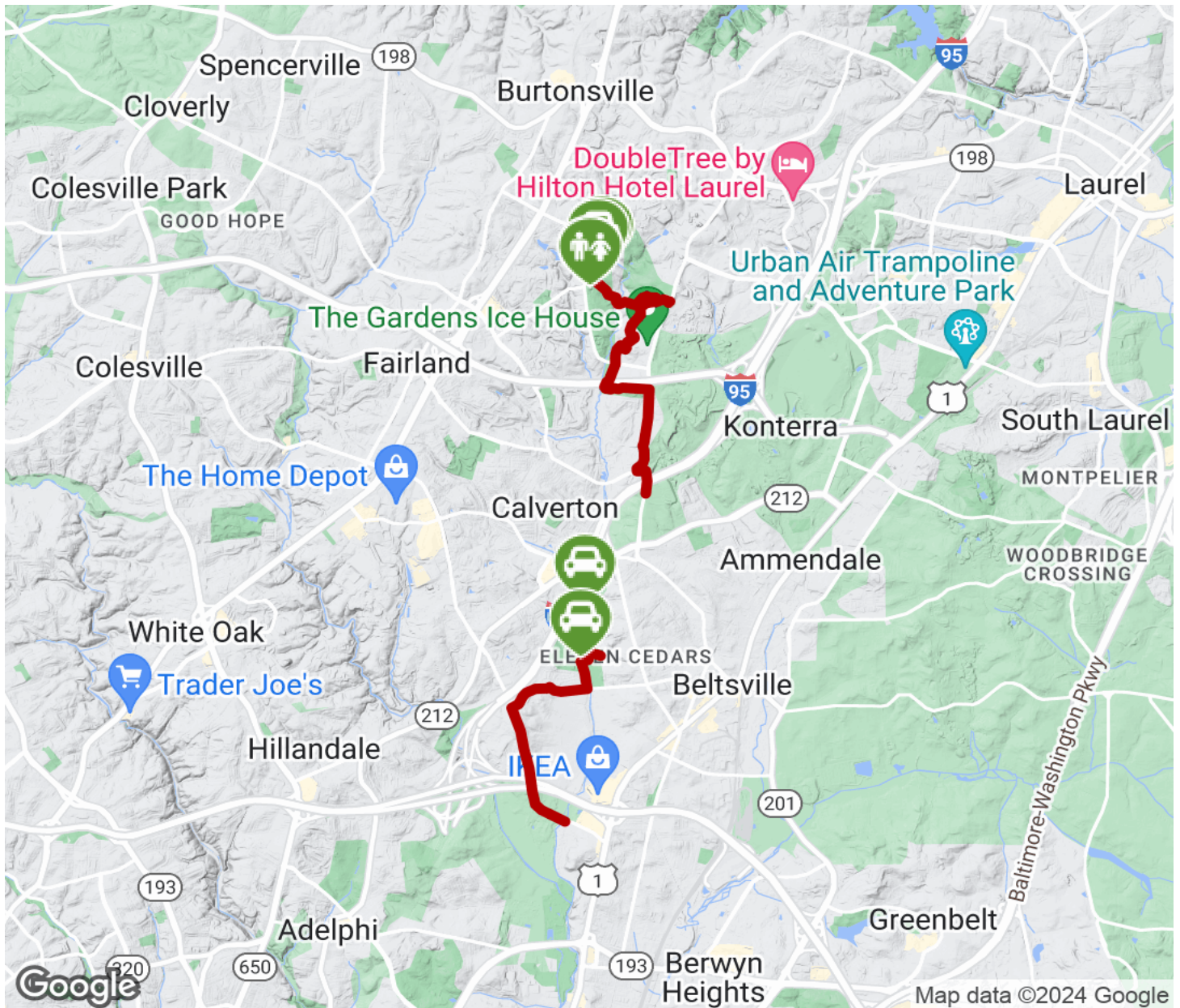
Parking & Trail Access
