The Broadneck Peninsula Trail is 1.2 miles of asphalt walking and biking pathway in east Annapolis. The trail runs parallel to College Parkway, from Green Holly Drive to Old Cape St. Claire Road, across from Broadneck Park. A spur reaches Broadneck Library and another to Walnut Ridge Drive. The second phase of the trail will stretch to Bay Dale Drive, and construction launched in the summer of 2018. The vision for the trail is for it to connect to the [Baltimore & Annapolis Trail](#).

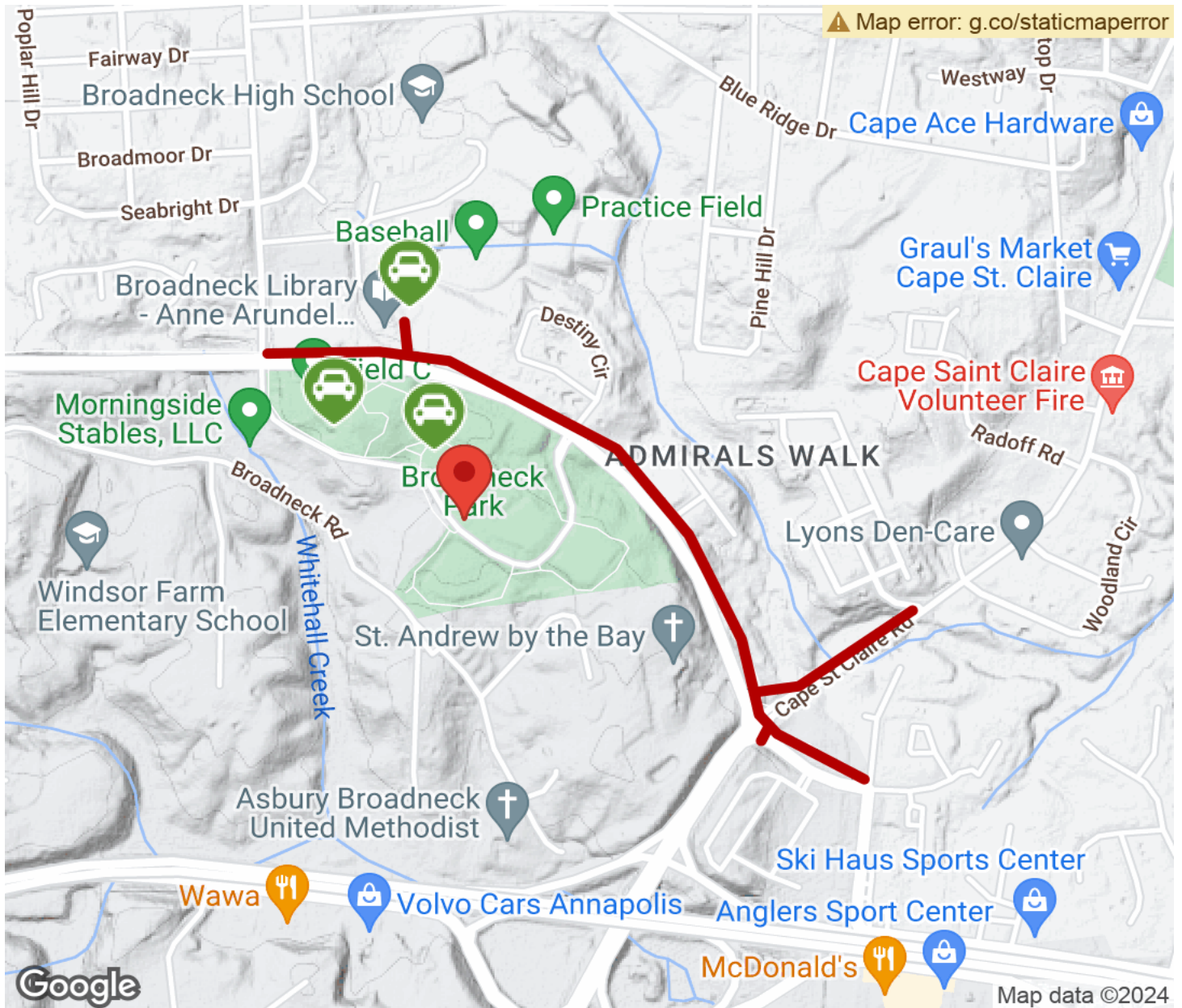
Parking & Trail Access
