A lovely excursion into nature with the opportunity to observe an abundance of wildlife. Perfect for hikers, bikers, and families with strollers. Pets on a leash are welcome.

Part of the Carolina Thread Trail, a system of trails and greenways in the Carolinas, the Wetland Trail connects with the <u>Piedmont Medical Center Trail</u> and the <u>Waterford Trail</u> via the <u>River Trail</u>.
