

Wasson Way Ohio



Overview Wasson Way runs between Montgomery Rd at the edge of Xavier University's campus and Old Red Bank Rd at the edge of Ault



another 1.2 miles stretching to Marburg Avenue.

The most recent additions to the trail, Phases 4 & 5, were finished in the winter of 2021, which continued the trail to the east into the wooded grounds of Ault Park. The trail's western end is currently at Old Red Bank Road, a short distance away from the start of the Fairfax Bike Trail at Woodland Road. The next phase of the trail is set to add another 0.8 miles.

Connections

When completed, the Wasson Way trail will span 7.6 miles from Victory Parkway (near Xavier University) to the <u>Little Miami Scenic Trail</u> in Newtown. The latter spans 78 miles from Cincinnati to Springfield and is in the Rail-Trail Hall of Fame.

Overview

Wasson Way runs between Montgomery Rd at the edge of Xavier University's campus and Old Red Bank Rd at the edge of Ault Park in Cincinnati.

About the Route

The first section of the developing Wasson Way trail opened in 2018 in the eastern Cincinnati neighborhood of Hyde Park. It measured less than a mile, running past Withrow High School, shops and restaurants as it traveled from Madison Road to Tamarack Avenue, near Dana Avenue and I-71. The second phase extended the trail west to Montgomery Road, and includes a bridge over I-71. Phase 3 extended it east, doubling the length by adding

Parking & Trail Access

Wasson Way runs between Montgomery Rd at the edge of Xavier University's campus and Old Red Bank Rd at the edge of Ault Park in Cincinnati.

Parking is available at several locations along the trail:

- in a small paved lot at the Evanston Playground (3558 Evanston Ave, Cincinnati)
- in the back lot of Withrow High School (2488 Madison Road, Cincinnati)
- near the football field and baseball diamonds at Rookwood Commons (3805 Edwards Rd, Cincinnati)
- Hyde Park Plaza (3760 Paxton Ave, Cincinnati)

There is street parking, including some accessible spaces, along Wasson Road. There are two accessible spaces in the Evanston Playground parking and multiple accessible spaces at the other locations.
