Looping around the lake at its center is a paved pathway, which offers views of the lake, wetlands and the surrounding native grasses. In addition to enjoying the trail, the 335-acre park provides opportunities for picnicking, wildlife viewing, fishing and boating.

East of the Prairie Queen Trail, spur trails provide access to Prairie Queen Elementary School and Werner Park.

Parking & Trail Access


Parking lots and restrooms are available off Cornhusker Road, just east of S. 132nd St., and off Lincoln Road, just west of S. 126th St.
