*Located in the Minneapolis suburb of Eden Prairie, Bryant Lake Regional Park offers 2.2 miles of immaculate paved trail cutting a*



Located in the Minneapolis suburb of Eden Prairie, Bryant Lake Regional Park offers 2.2 miles of immaculate paved trail cutting a swathe through grassy fields, shady woodlands and wetlands. The trail runs between I-62 and Bryant Lake Drive with a branch looping close to the lake. The trail's northern end is about 1.5 miles south of the [Minnesota River Bluffs LRT Regional Trail](#), but you can make the connection by taking the gravel and asphalt pathway north to Rowland Road, and then taking the sidepath along Rowland up to where it meets the longer trail.

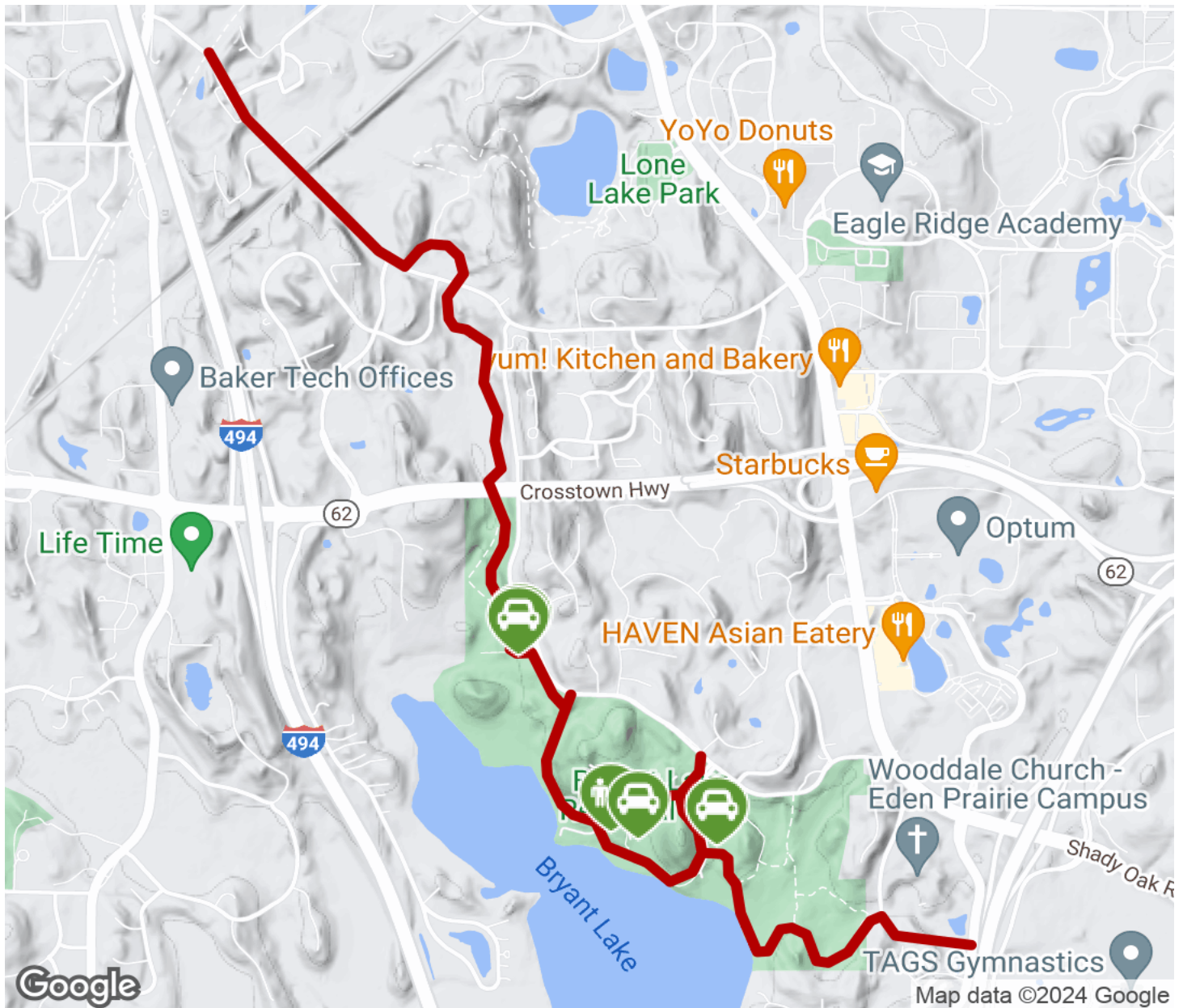
## Parking & Trail Access
