## The Erica Greif Memorial Bikeway is a multipurpose, off-street path paralleling Veterans Parkway, also known as the Southeast



The Erica Greif Memorial Bikeway is a multipurpose, offstreet path paralleling Veterans Parkway, also known as the Southeast Connector, which connects Reno to Sparks. The walking and biking path was named for Erica Greif, a University of Nevada, Reno student and cycling enthusiast who died in 2015 in a car accident on her way to a California bike race. Sun protection is your friend as there is no shade to obscure the desert sun, but there are benches where folks can rest if they need to.

## **Parking & Trail Access**


There is no dedicated parking for this trail, but parking is available near the southern end at Double Diamond Park (9100 Wilbur May Pkwy) and at Cyan Park (2121 Long Meadow Dr, Reno).

To reach the trail from Double Diamond Park, briefly head east along S Meadows Parkway which has an unprotected bike lane and a sidewalk. To reach the trail from Cyan Park, head north along Veterans Parkway. It also has an unprotected bike lane and a sidewalk. Take appropriate precautions.
