Running through a quiet neighborhood in the western reaches of Omaha, the Huntington Park Trailway (also known more simply as the Huntington Trail) offers a nice concrete path, ideal for residents looking for a walking or jogging route. The trail leads from shops and restaurants along 156th Street to the small neighborhood recreation site at Huntington Park, which offers a playground and tennis court. The <u>West Papio Trail</u> runs through the park, a crucial component in the area's trail network that allows trail users to travel all the way into Bellevue; the Huntington Park Trailway thus allows nearby residents access to this larger trail and also connects those traveling the West Papio with nearby eateries - a welcome amenity after a day out on the trail.


Parking & Trail Access
