Indian Creek Greenway is a hike-and-bike asphalt pathway that sits in the swathe cut by Indian Creek through residential Morrisville. About a third of the trail parallels Town Hall Road as a dedicated sidepath, concluding at the official trailhead. The trailhead includes 17 parking spaces, restrooms and picnic shelters and a children's play area. Smaller access paths reach into the subdivisions, inviting residents to take advantage of the trail for fitness and for recreation.


Parking & Trail Access
