The Windy Creek Trail is a 0.7-mile, eight-foot wide trail in Tell City, Perry County. The path is flat, asphalt and usable for a range



The Windy Creek Trail is a 0.7-mile, eight-foot wide trail in Tell City, Perry County. The path is flat, asphalt and usable for a range of non-motorized uses including walking, jogging, cycling and walking dogs. The trail begins on Payne Street/ State Route 37 and snakes along Windy Creek through Hagerdon Park. The park features a range of sports amenities including a pool, baseball diamonds and tennis courts. There is also an off-leash dog park.

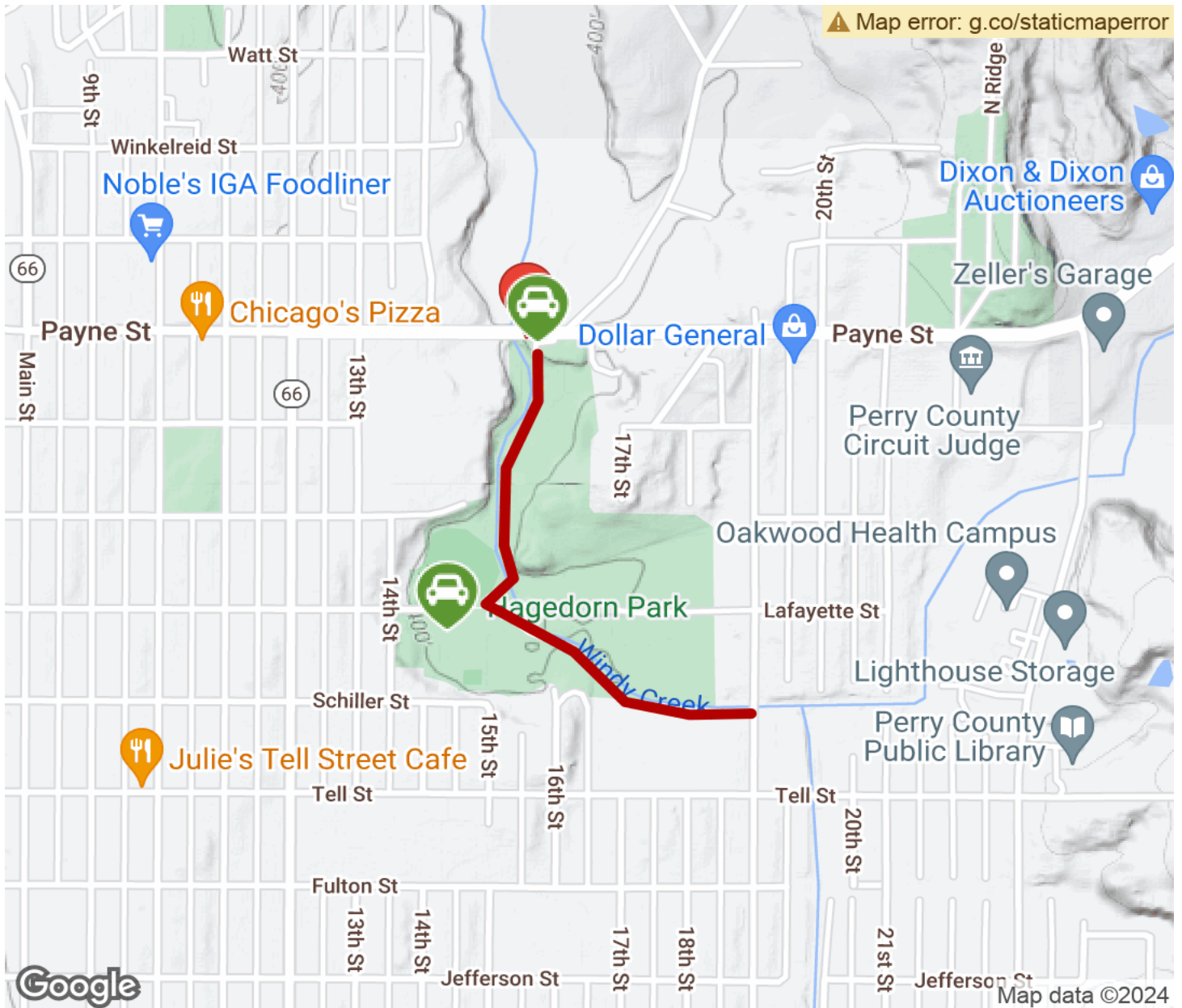
Parking & Trail Access
