The Schuylkill River runs through the park, which is composed of East Fairmount Park and West Fairmount Park. Fairmount Park is home to a wide variety of cultural, historical, and recreational attractions including numerous trails, woods and fields, historical sites, multiple museums, art centers and performing spaces, athletic fields and courts, playgrounds, a variety of gardens, water features, and lots more.

The [MLK Drive Trail](#) and the [Schuylkill River Trail](#) wind through the park. Additional pathways connect the park's amenities and attractions. There are also several hiking trails with rougher terrain.
