## **Seven Mile Loop Trail** *Florida*




#### The Seven Mile Loop Trail is located in the Crystal River Preserve State Park (3266 N Sailboat Ave, Crystal River). Winding through



The Seven Mile Loop Trail is located in the Crystal River Preserve State Park (3266 N Sailboat Ave, Crystal River). Winding through Florida's diverse coastal habitats, the route crosses three freshwater tidal creeks and passes through pine flatwoods, saltwater marsh flats, and freshwater swamps. Enjoy observing a wide variety of wildlife including deer, otters, alligators, squirrels, rabbits, crabs, tortoises, turtles, armadillos, numerous birds, and freshwater minnows. As a designated stop on the Great Florida Birding & Wildlife Trail, the trail is quite popular with the birdwatchers. The flora and fauna found along the trail includes a variety of beautiful wildflowers.

The out-and-back trail is initially a straight line before forming a loop. The surface is primarily dirt and trail conditions are subject to weather. The 7-mile trail can be
