The North Mendota trail is a 12-ft wide asphalt trail that connects Waunakee and Governor Nelson State Park, on the shores of Lake



The North Mendota trail is a 12-ft wide asphalt trail that connects Waunakee and Governor Nelson State Park, on the shores of Lake Mendota. Starting at the northern trailhead in the village of Waunakee, the North Mendota Trail follows Woodland Dr for the first half of the trail until turning onto to Highway M and crossing over Six-Mile Creek via boardwalk. The trail then follows a short on-road section along N Shore Bay Dr. Then the trail winds south for another mile, passing through Governor Nelson State Park.

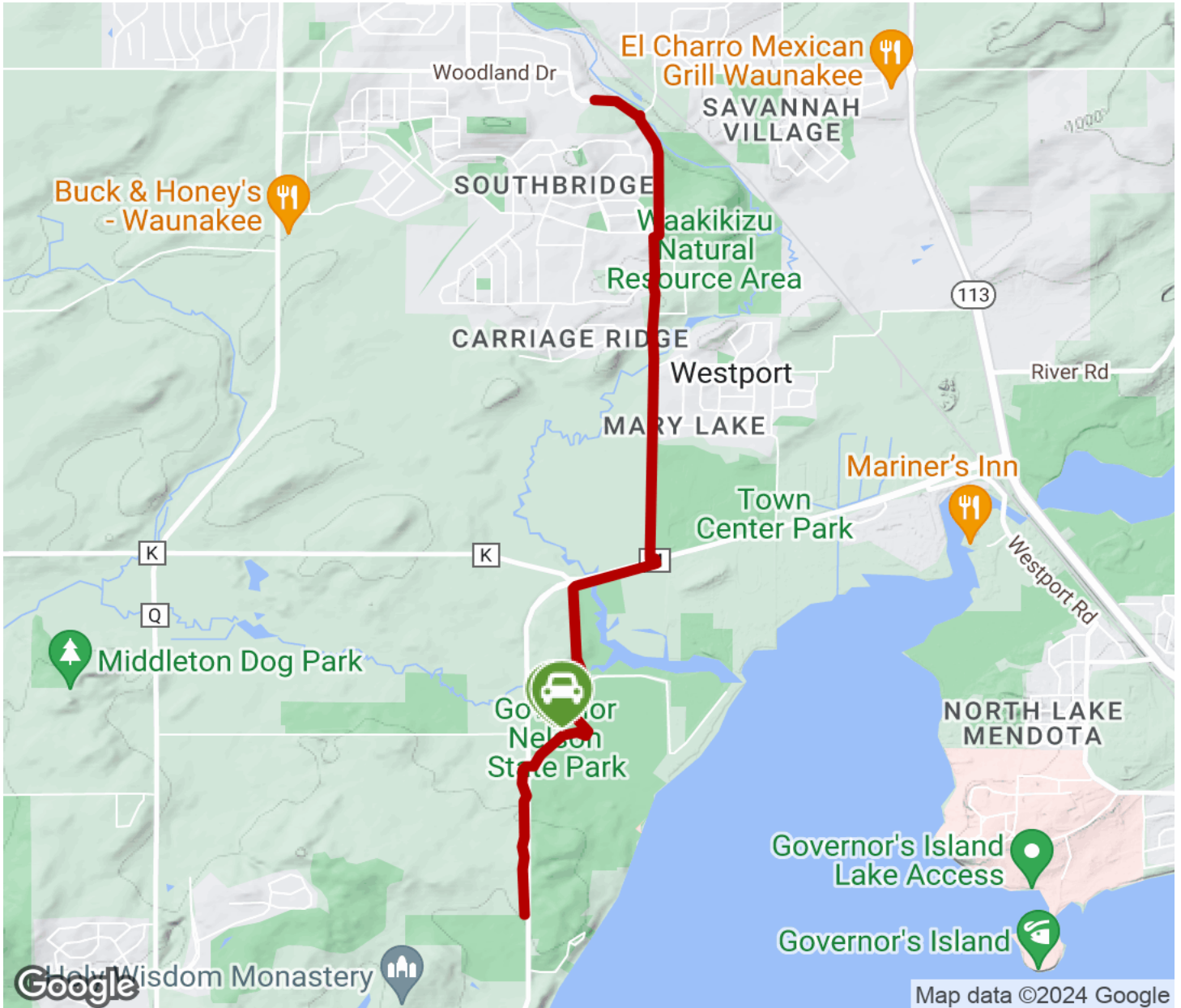
