Como Lake, and encompassing Como Regional Park, represents an impressive community resource. The 450-acre park features an 18-hole golf course, zoo, pool, conservatory and the namesake Como Lake, where there is a fishing pier and kayak & paddleboard rental available in the summer.

The Como Lake Trail winds 1.8 miles around the lake. It is a one-way street that follows a counterclockwise direction.

From the lake loop, trail users can also take advantage of a nearly one-mile spur trail that heads south through residential streets and over the railroad via an impressive boardwalk bridge. This spur trail is ideal for local residents looking to access the lake loop and

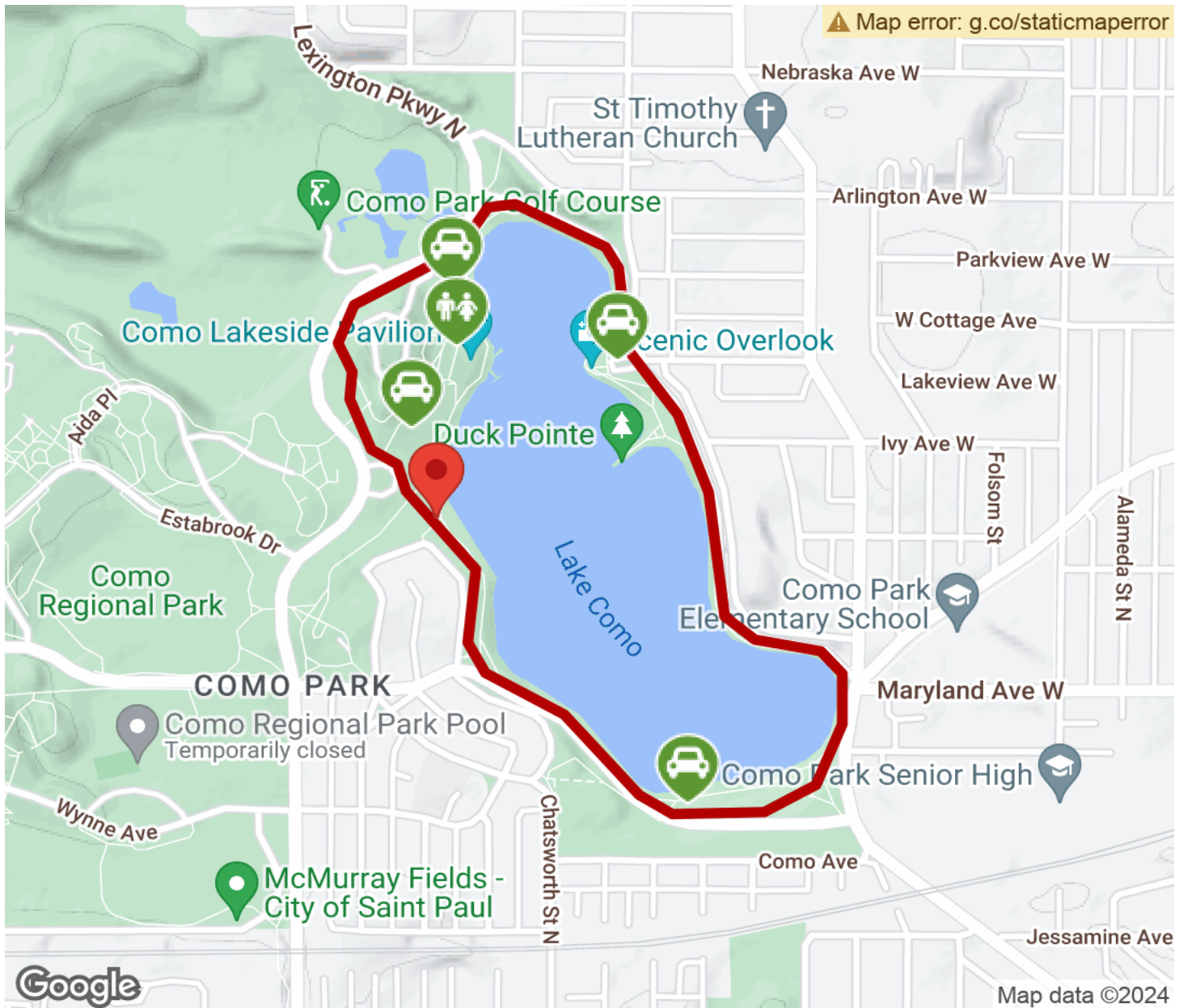
Parking & Trail Access
