Heart of Vilas Bike Trail

Wisconsin



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The [Heart of Vilas Bike Trail](#), recognized as a National Recreation Trail, is a 52 mile bike trail that spans the width of Vilas County and some of Iron County Wisconsin.

The trail spans the towns of Mercer, Manitowish Waters, Boulder Junction, Sayner and St. Germain and is made up of five distinct trail sections, listed (west-east) below:

[Mercer Hike and Bike Trail](#) (9 miles):

Mercer, an outdoors-lovers destination famous for its 378,000 acres of Public Forestland and the massive Turtle Flambeau Flowage, is a great starting point for the Heart of Vilas Bike Trail. The northernmost endpoint of the trail is located near Carow Park, where the trail then continues

southeast through Mercer and east towards Manitowish Waters. A hallmark of the trail is the impressive 40-ft bridge was constructed over the Manitowish River.

The eastern end of the trail connects with the [Manitowish Waters Bike Trail](#) along two different endpoints, the first along Tower Rd. along the main strip of Manitowish Waters, which connects users to the rest of the Heart of Vilas Bike Trail and the second located near the Manitowish Waters Town Hall, where the western endpoint of the Manitowish Waters Bike Trail is located.

[Manitowish Waters Bike Trail](#) (18.6 miles):

Starting from the Manitowish Waters Town Hall, where the trail's western endpoint is located, the Manitowish Waters Bike Trail winds north through the town and from there, carves a rural route from Manitowish Waters all the way to Boulder Junction. The trail's route passes through the Pappoose Creek Pines State Natural Area, past Big Lake and Clear Lake until reaching Boulder Junction.

The eastern end of this trail along Main Street connects with the [Crystal Lake Trail](#). A spur along County Highway M heads north from Boulder Junction Main Street.

This portion of the trail features fixtations (a bicycle repair and pump) at the intersection of Hwy K & H just outside of Boulder Junction and along 5733 Airport Rd. in Manitowish Waters (town hall).

[Crystal Lake Trail](#) (11 miles):

The Crystal Lake Trail runs between downtown Boulder Junction (where it connects with the [Manitowish Waters Bike Trail](#)) and the the Crystal Lake Campground in northern Wisconsin, passing Trout Lake along the way. The fully-paved trail offers an ideal ride for touring bikes as well as groups riding with younger children. There are lots of places to stop

There are numerous parking options along this 52-mile route.

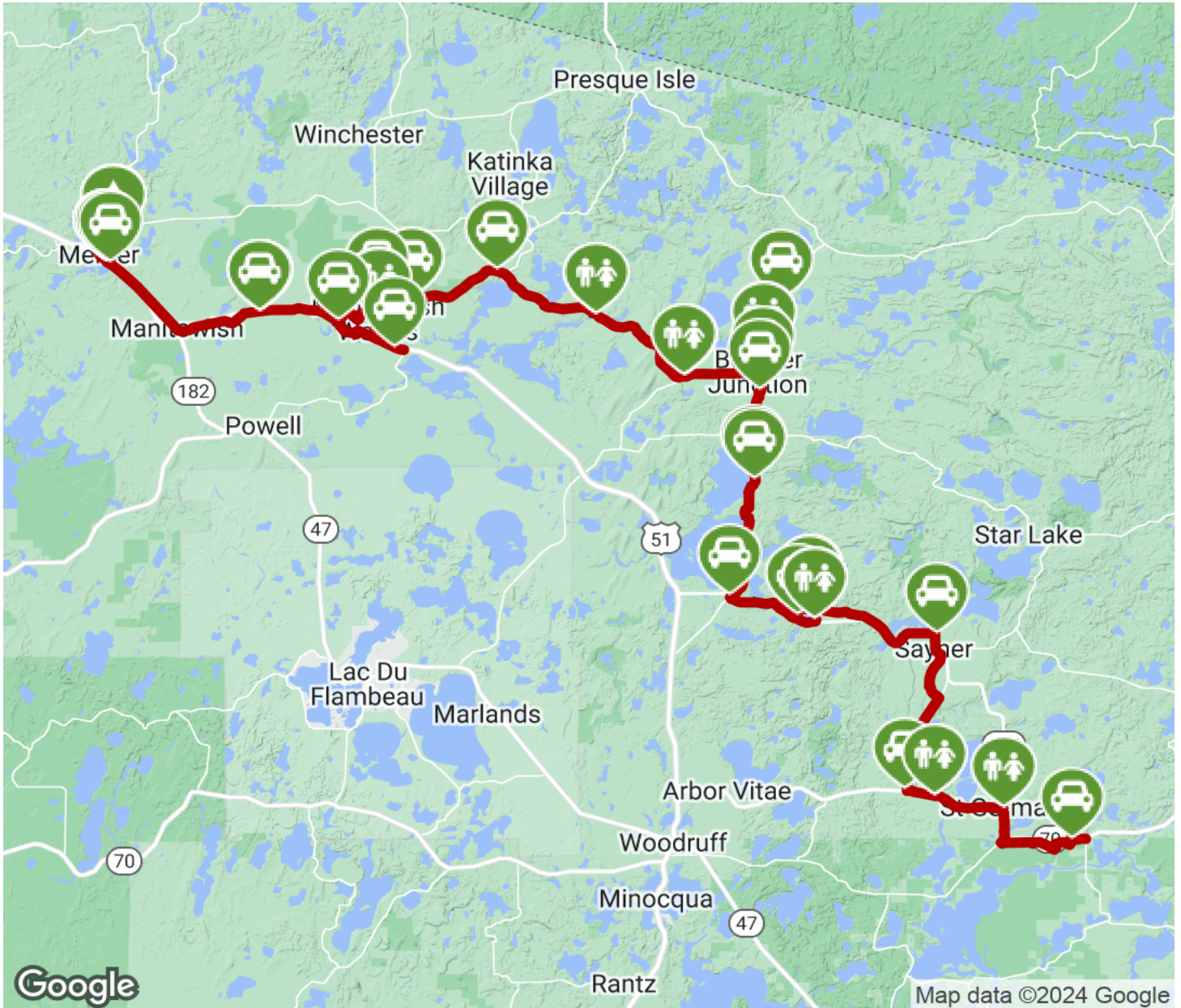
