This pleasant, flat rail-trail parallels Capoolong Creek through the Capoolong Creek Wildlife Management Area for nearly 4 miles. The surface is varied, so the trail is best suited for hiking or mountain biking. The experience is one of quiet woodlands with opportunities for observing many types of birds, deer, and other animals.

Those wishing for a longer adventure, can pick up the nearby [Landsdown Trail](#), which begins in Landsdown and continues nearly 2 miles northward.

Parking & Trail Access

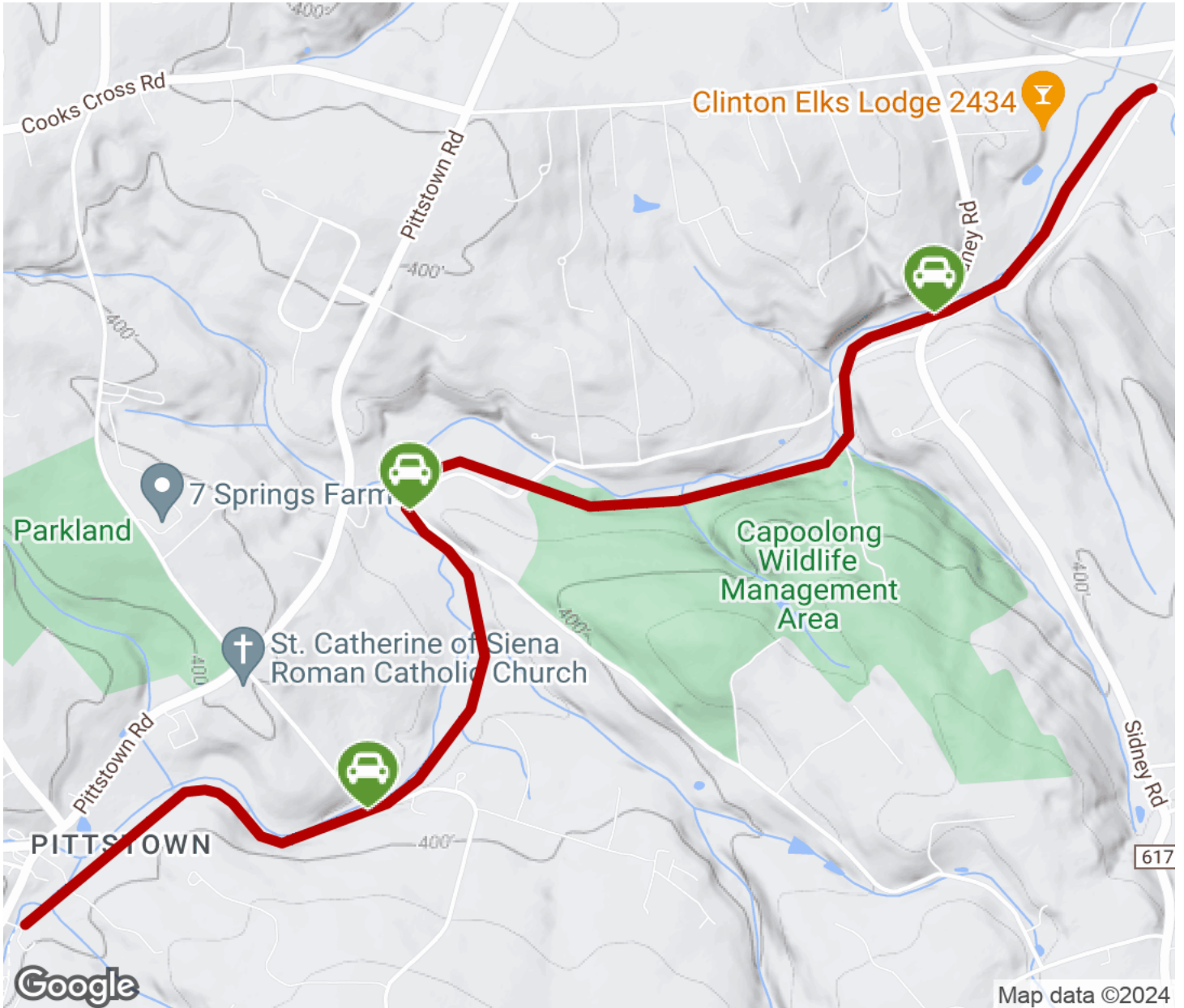
Visitors to the trail can park at locations including (from south to north):

- Kingtown Road, off of Pittstown Road/ CR 513 - 3.8 miles south of Clinton,
- Sidney Road (CR 617) & Lower Kingtown Road (3.1 miles south of Clinton)
