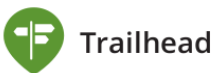
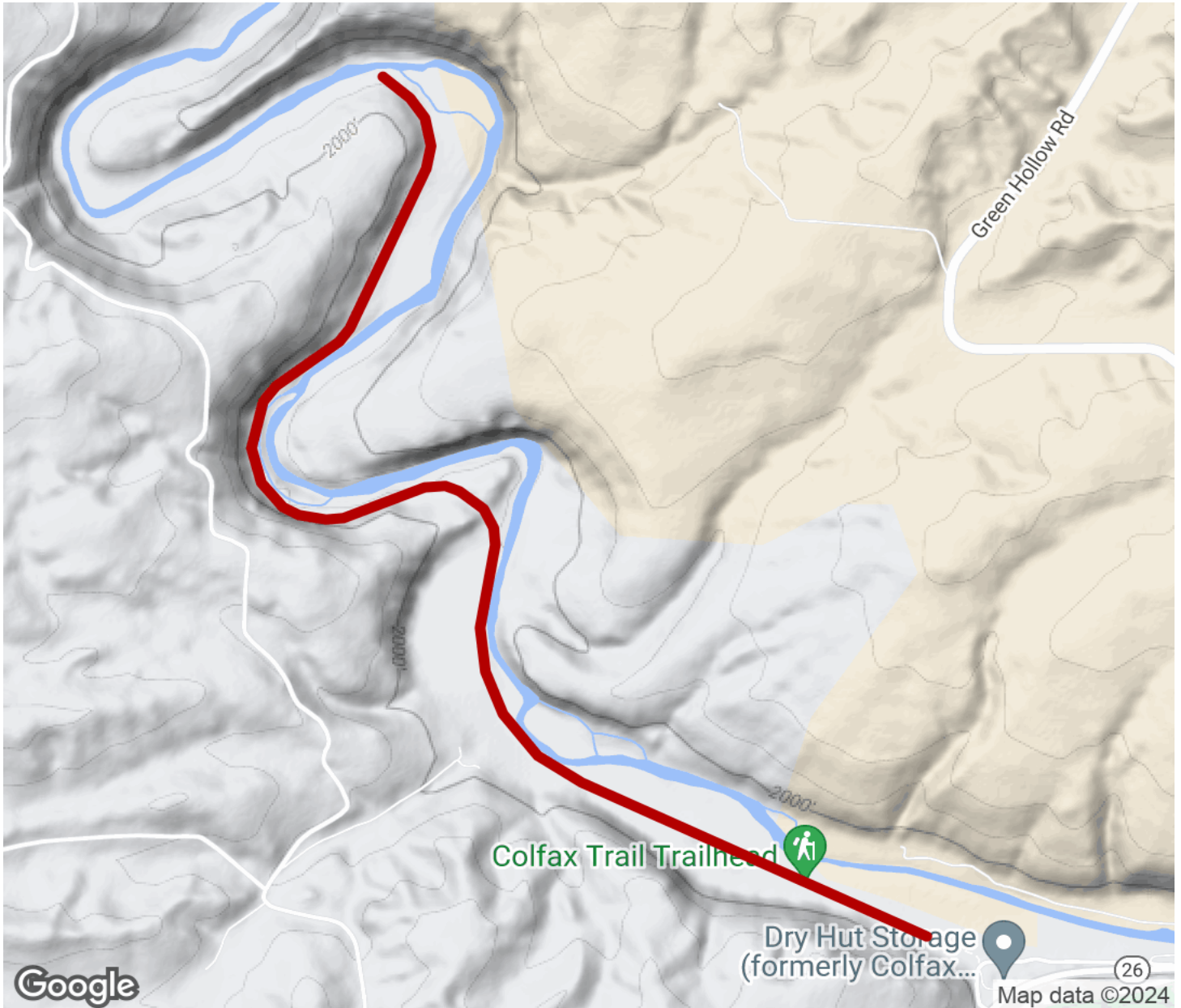
From town, take SR 26 (Walla Walla Highway) west and bear right on W. River Drive. Continue through the industrial site to the trailhead at the other end.
