

The 6.1-mile Clarksville Greenway follows an abandoned rail bed on the outskirts of Clarksville north of town. The greenway meanders



The 6.1-mile Clarksville Greenway follows an abandoned rail bed on the outskirts of Clarksville north of town. The greenway meanders along a creek through a route canopied with large trees. The greenway helps establish a buffer along the Red River and nearby streams, while providing a habitat for diverse plant and animal species. There is a bike-share station at the Pollard Road Trailhead if you need to rent a bike for the ride.
