Aldridge Creek Greenway

Alabama

This paved greenway trail is well maintained and follows Aldridge Creek, running parallel to Bailey Cove Road, from Mountain Gap



This paved greenway trail is well maintained and follows Aldridge Creek, running parallel to Bailey Cove Road, from Mountain Gap Road to Green Cove Road. Rabbits, turtles and various other wildlife can be seen on the trail, and it is popular with local birdwatchers. The trail passes under all main roads, making it safe at crossings.

A disconnected half-mile extension was added on to the trail in 2018, created a paved pathway along the creek from Weatherly Road to Esslinger Road.

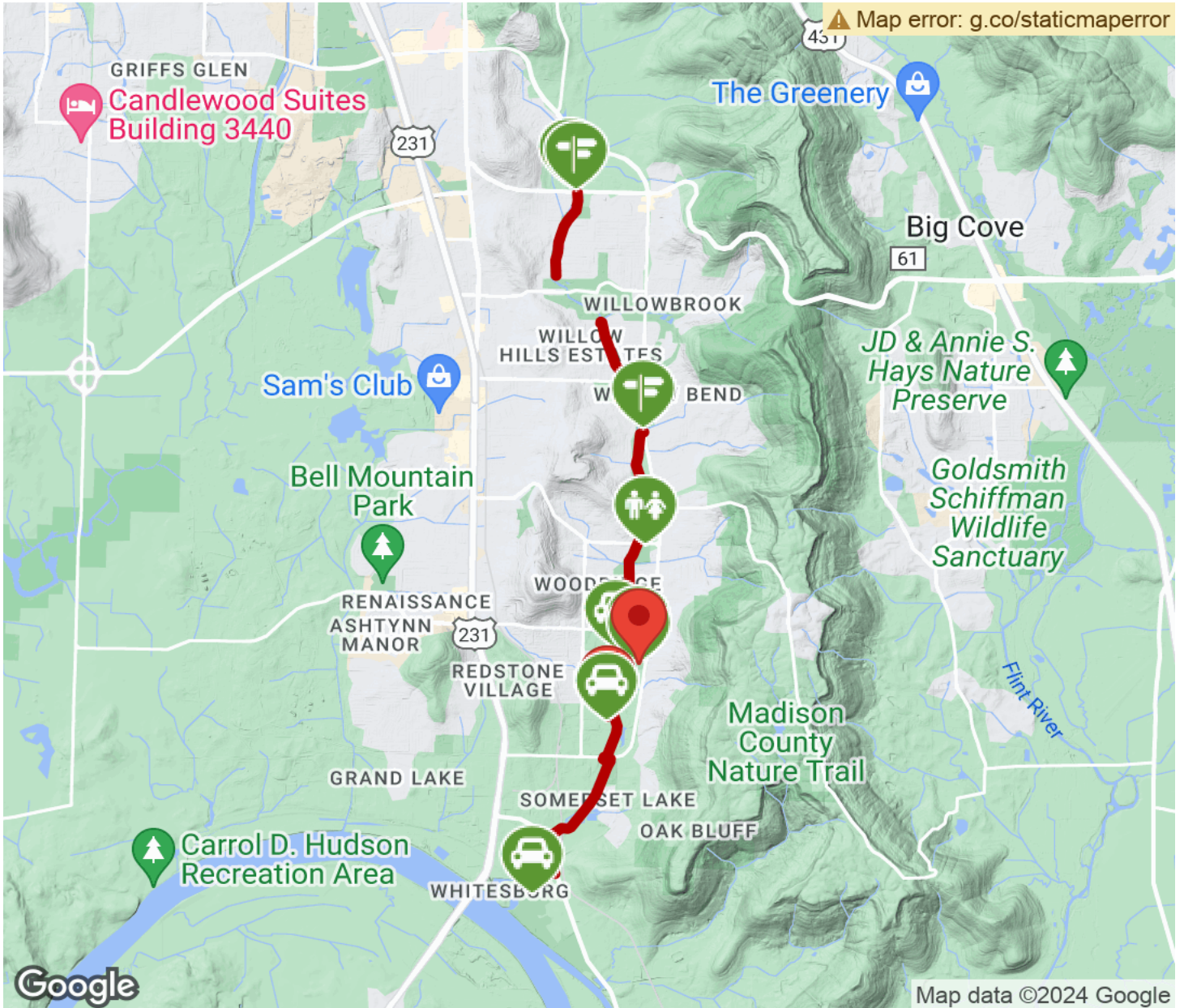
Parking & Trail Access

From Huntsville, turn onto Hobbs Island Road off Hwy 231 (Memorial Parkway, South Huntsville); it's the last road before the Tennessee River Bridge. Take the first right onto Ditto Landing Road SE. You can park at any of the public parking in Ditto Landing, but be aware that it closes at sundown. Parking is also available at Ken Johnston Park in Huntsville
