The Union Valley Bike Trail is a two-lane, paved route that connects the campgrounds on the east side of Union Valley Reservoir in the



The Union Valley Bike Trail is a two-lane, paved route that connects the campgrounds on the east side of Union Valley Reservoir in the Eldorado National Forest. The trail skirts the shores of the reservoir between Jones Fork and Wench Creek campgrounds. The trail offers a non-motorized way for campers to access Jones Fork and Wench Creek.

The forested trail offers glimpses of Union Valley, which is now a reservoir; low water in late summer makes for a receded shoreline. Interpretive signs tell about Union Valley and its water resources.

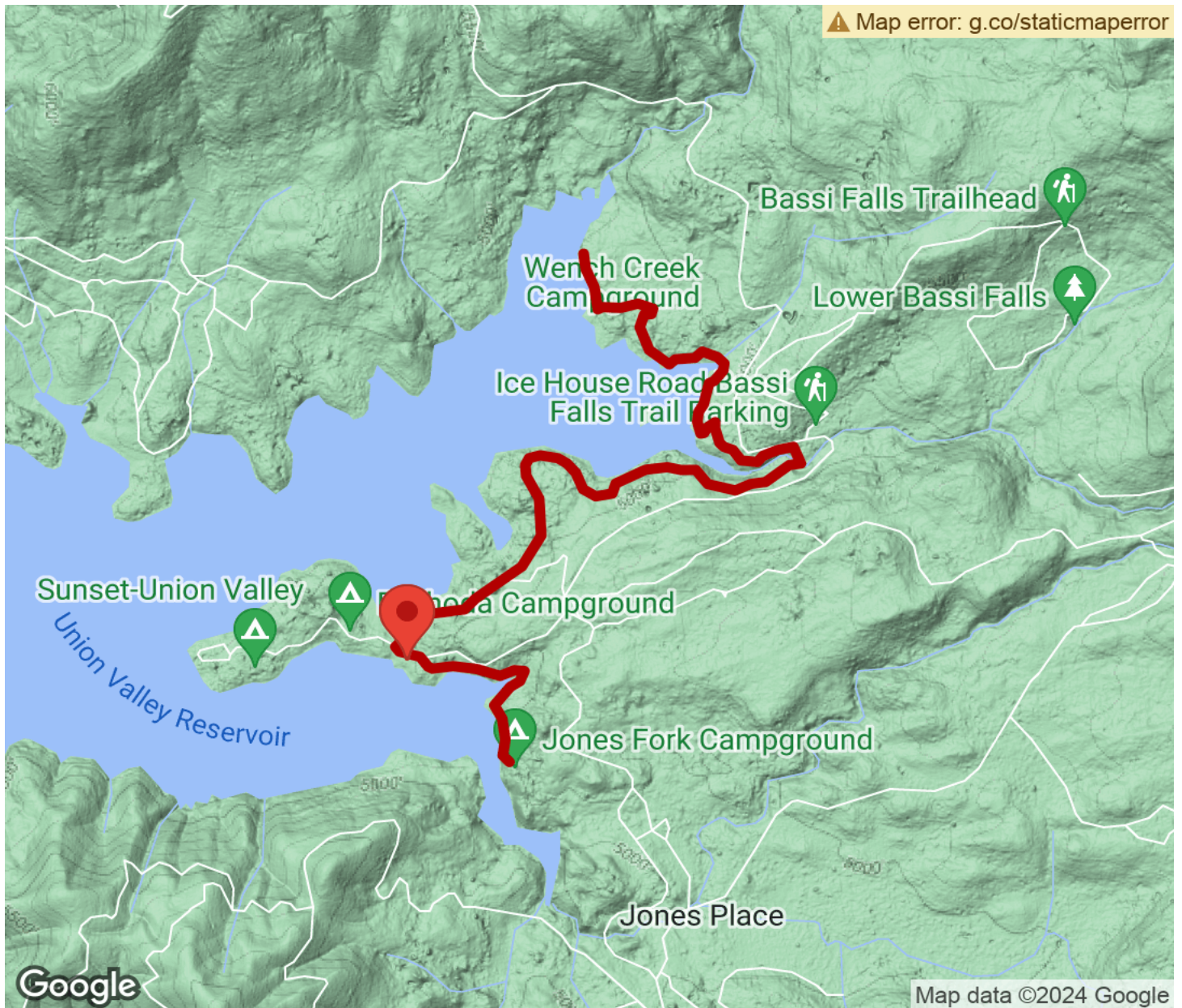
Parking & Trail Access
