The Equestrian North Trail extends south and then east from Equestrian Park North, which features a plethora of amenities for horses and their riders, including an arena, holding pen and trailer parking. This trail, while primarily intended for equestrian users, also welcomes walkers.

Across S. Magic Way, the trail connects to the paved [Saguaro Trail](#). At its southwest edge, the path links to the paved [Equestrian South Trail](#) in Equestrian Park South. In the east, the trail merges into the [River Mountains Loop Trail](#), a 35-mile route linking Henderson with the Lake Mead National Recreation Area, Hoover Dam and Boulder City.

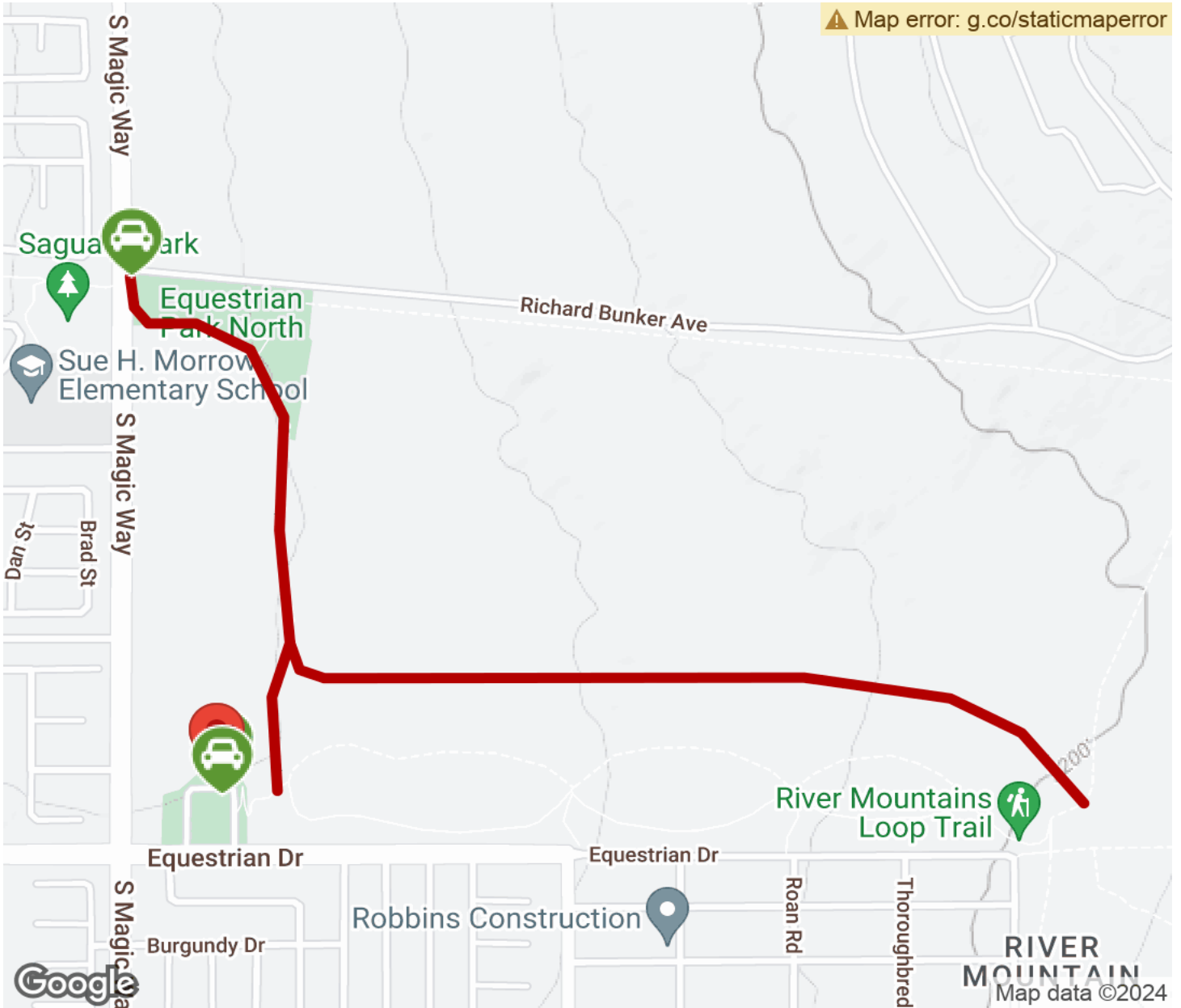
