The Yellowstone Road Greenway offers a 1-mile connector between two other trails, the Dry Creek Greenway and the Lions Park



The Yellowstone Road Greenway offers a 1-mile connector between two other trails, the [Dry Creek Greenway](#) and the [Lions Park Greenway](#).

The trail begins between McCormick Junior High School and Central High School, providing an important commuting route for children and teachers. From there, the trail travels south through residential areas to end at Lions Park, one of Cheyenne's best-loved parks with playgrounds, picnic shelters, athletic fields and a pool. South of the park, travelers can enjoy Sloan Lake's beaches and opportunities to boat and fish, or continue their journey around the lake to reach the Cheyenne Botanic Gardens, a popular city attraction.

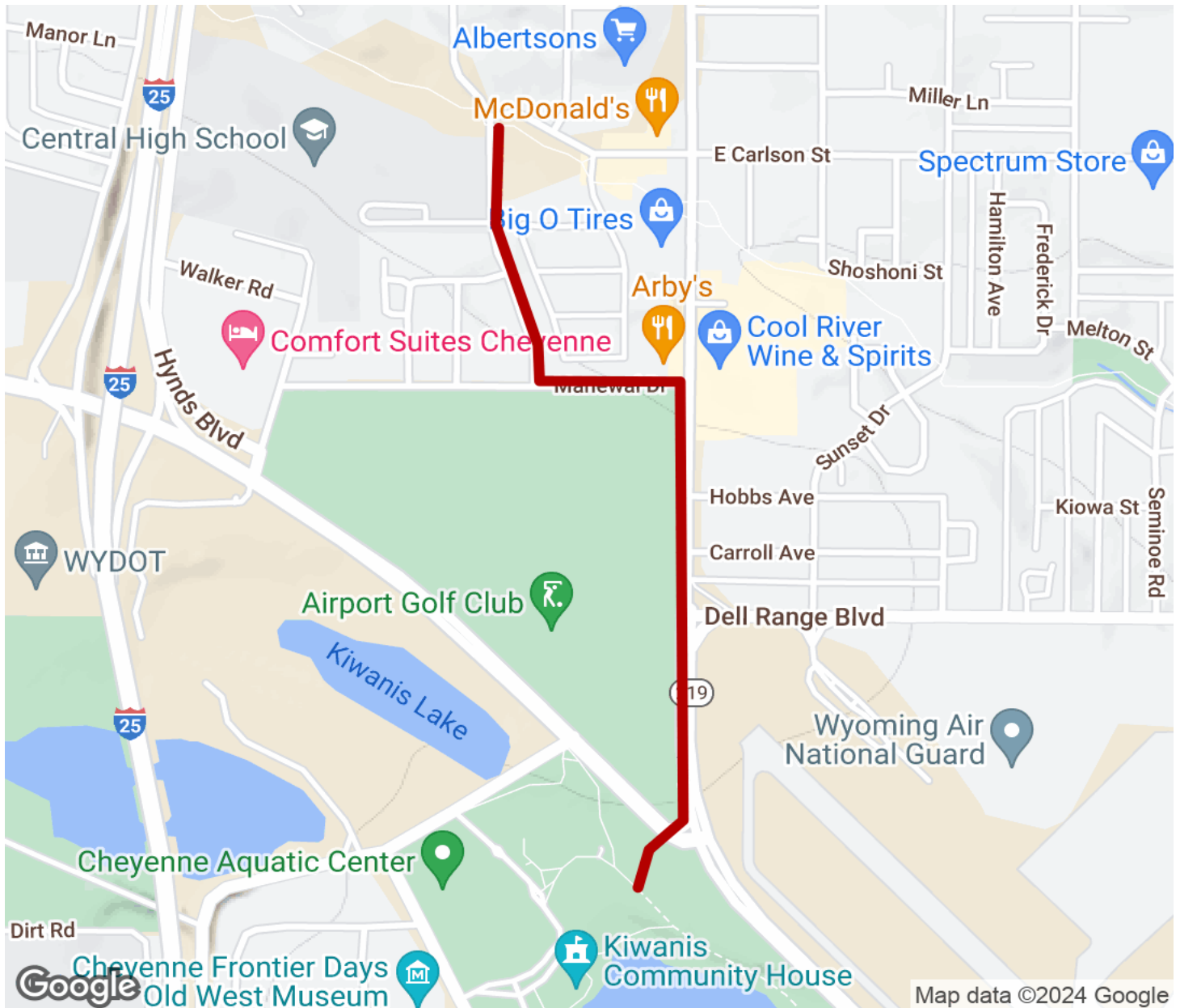
Parking & Trail Access
