The trail follows the seashore from campus to the park; a side loop swings north across the irrigation channel to a parking lot on Sandspit Road. 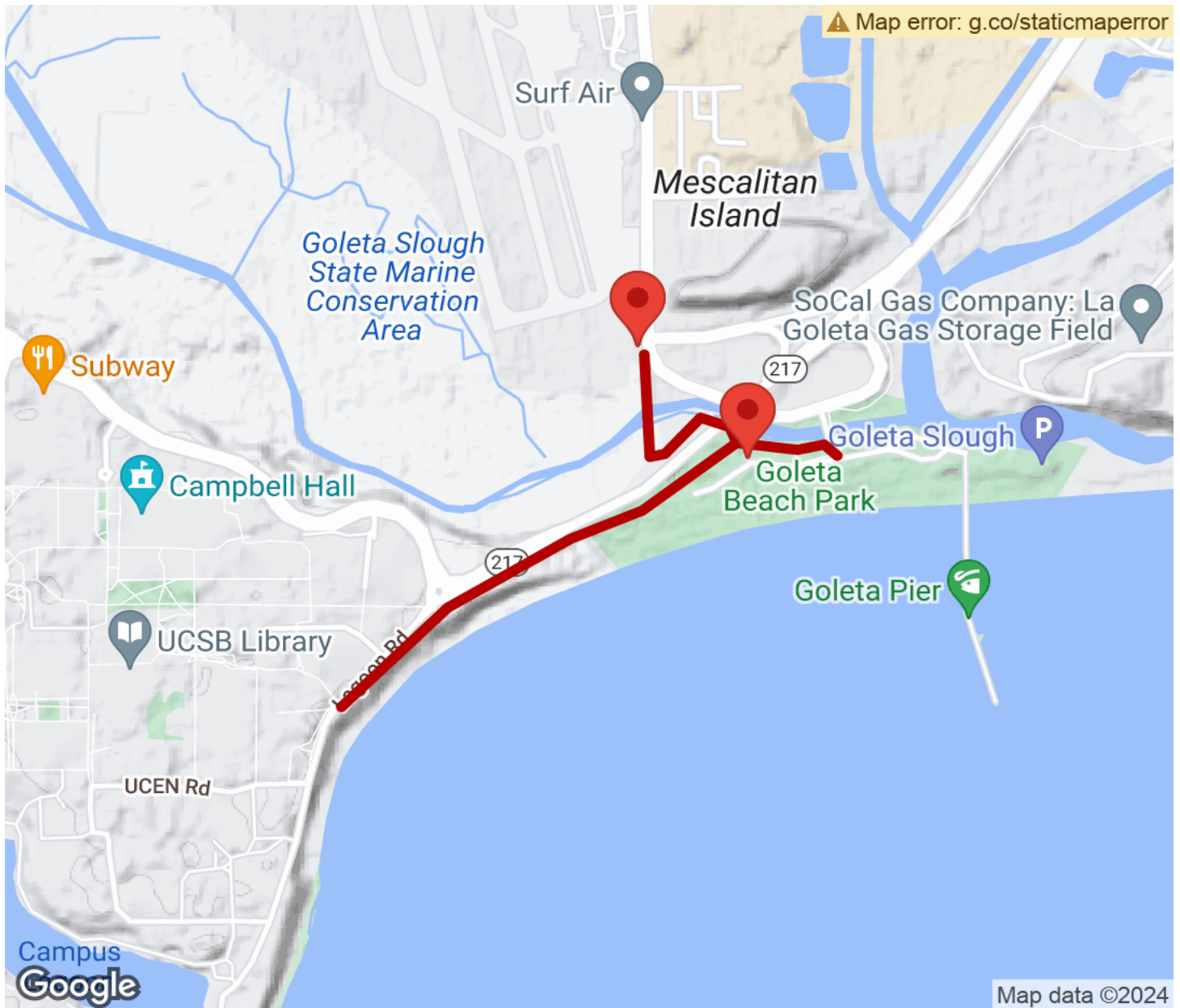
Parking & Trail Access
