The Bald Hill Multi-Modal Path runs for 1.3 miles at the base of a hill along the eastern edge of the Bald Hill Natural Area, which contains a diverse ecosystem of prairie, hardwood forests and wetlands. Several natural surface hiking and mountain biking paths weave throughout the recreational area. Wildflowers line the trail in the spring months.

From near the trail's midpoint, take the [Midge Cramer Multi-Use Path](#) east to the Benton County Fairgrounds on SW 53rd Street.

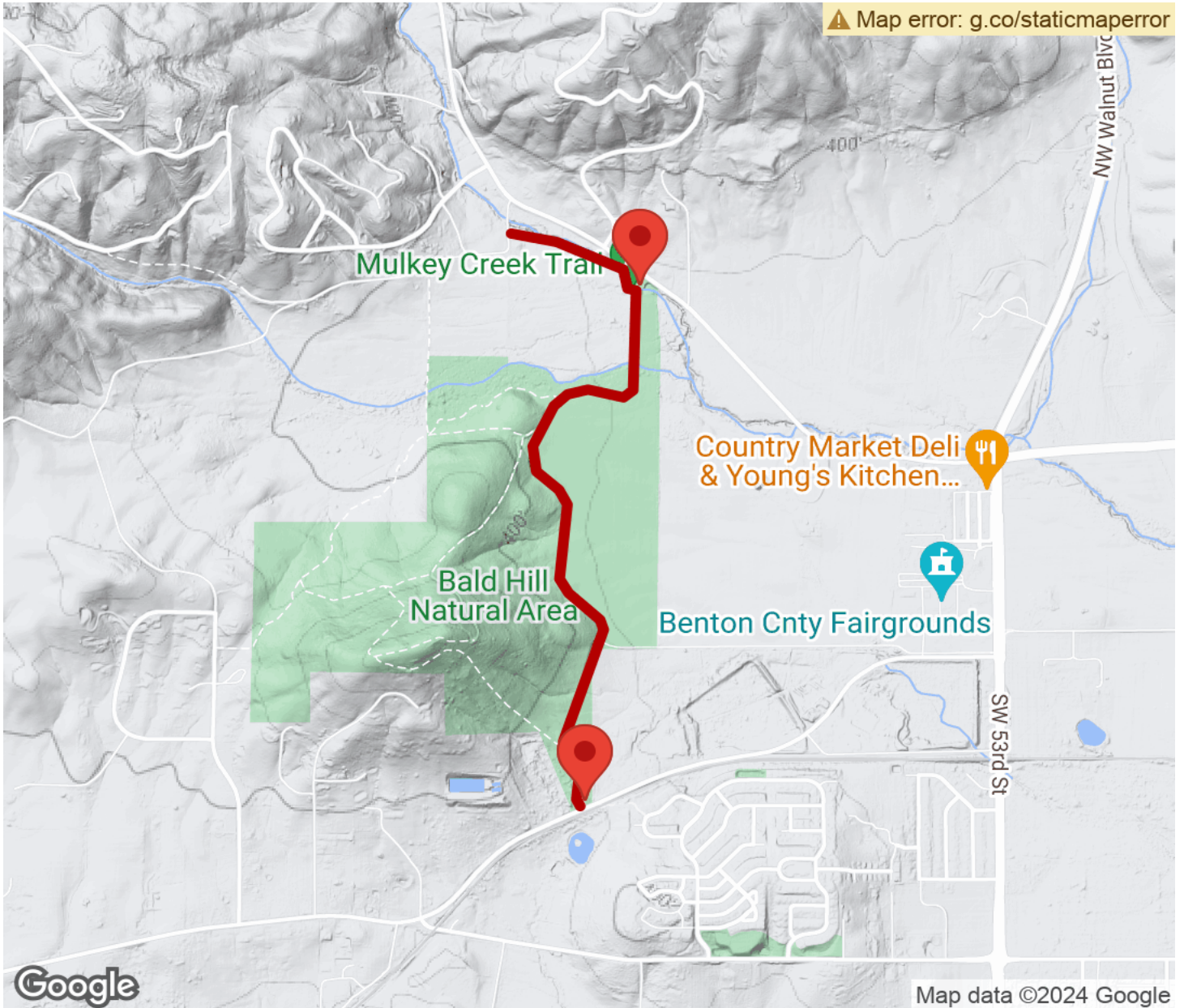
Parking & Trail Access
