The Buckeye Scenic Trail, a recent addition to the expanding Licking County trail system, stretches roughly 6 miles from the



The Buckeye Scenic Trail, a recent addition to the expanding Licking County trail system, stretches roughly 6 miles from the northern reaches of Heath to Lakewood High School on US 40. In the north, the paved trail passes commercial properties and Heath High School, while farther south trail users are treated to views of verdant Ohio farmland and well-kept homesteads.

At Irving Wick Drive, the rail-trail connects to the extensive Heath Trail System; head west to reach the city's municipal offices and pool complex.

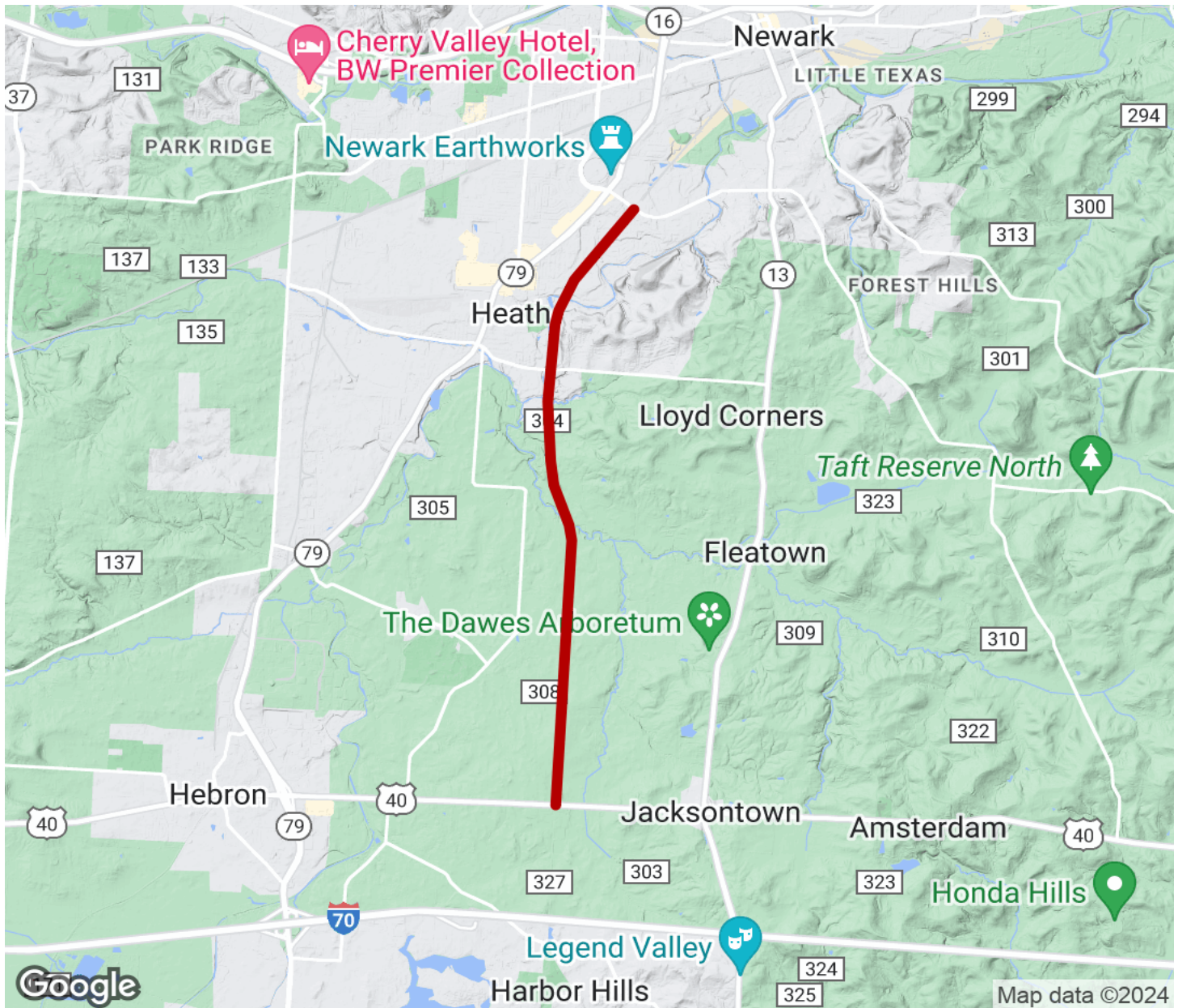
Parking & Trail Access
