The DeKalb-Sycamore Trail—also known as the Peace Road Trail—parallels the eastern side of Peace Road from DeKalb to Sycamore



The DeKalb-Sycamore Trail—also known as the Peace Road Trail—parallels the eastern side of Peace Road from DeKalb to Sycamore in northern Illinois. Along the way, you'll pass a mixture of residential neighborhoods, businesses and open fields.

A spur at Bethany Road runs just shy of 1 mile north to South Prairie Elementary School. From here, the trail heads east on an on-road route along quiet residential streets and through Sycamore Community Park to reach the [Great Western Trail](#), a 17-mile rail-trail that travels to St. Charles.

Near the southern end of the trail, another short spur offers a connection to both the [DeKalb Nature Trail](#) and [Kishwaukee-Kiwanis Trail](#).

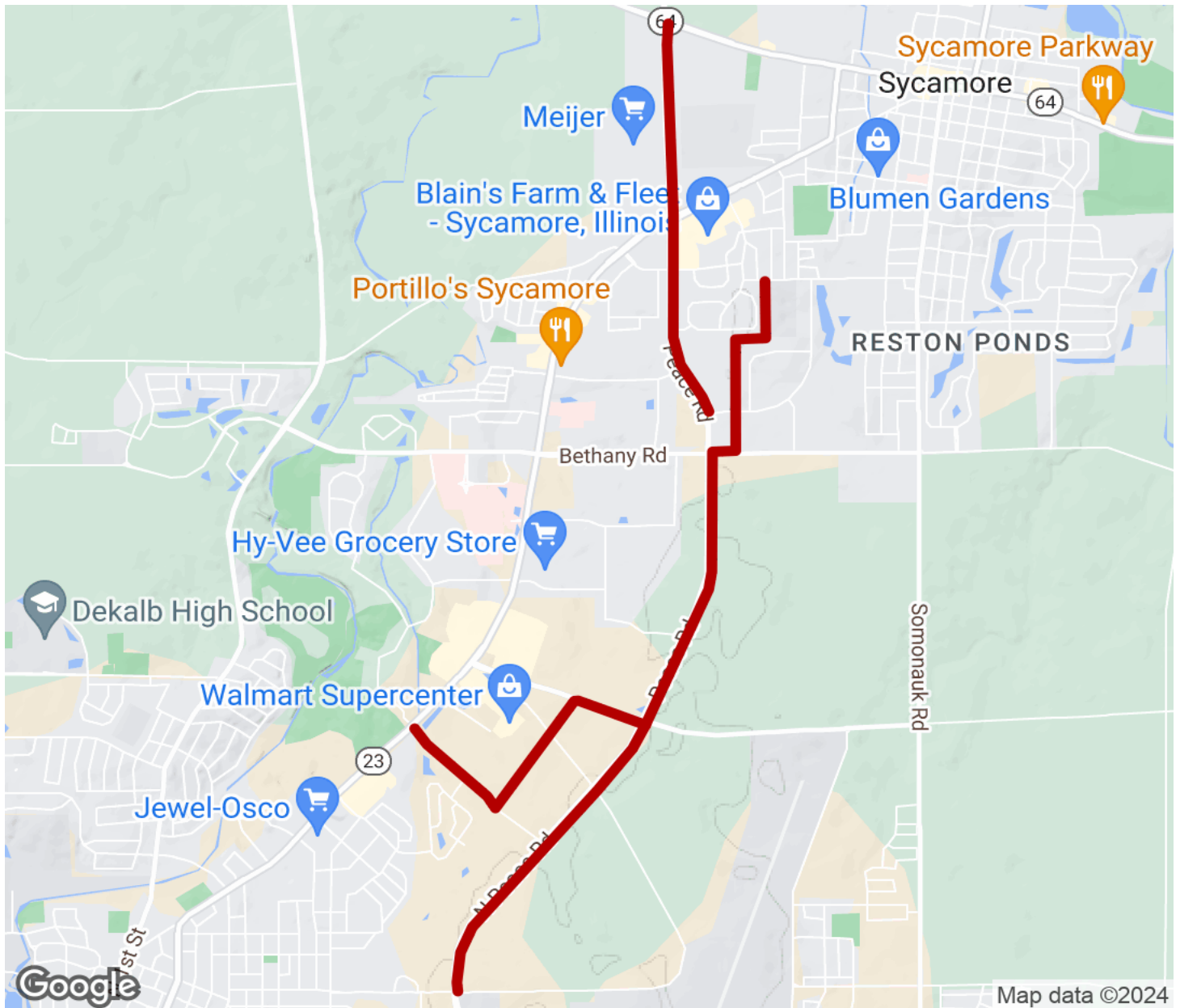
Parking & Trail Access
