The name Pufferbelly comes from the historical nickname for a steam locomotive. As of 2023, the rail-trail stretches 9.3 miles. The north end of the trail begins in the Pentolina Grove neighborhood and, from there, the trail heads south towards Fort Wayne. A highlight of the route is the trail's passage through Salomon Farm Park, where the Pufferbelly connects to a loop trail.

In the future, the trail will span 13 miles along a former New York Central railroad corridor. When finished, the rail-trail will stretch from downtown Fort Wayne to the northern Allen County border. A direct connection to the [Rivergreenway](#) will allow for extensive recreational and commuting access throughout Fort Wayne on foot or bike.

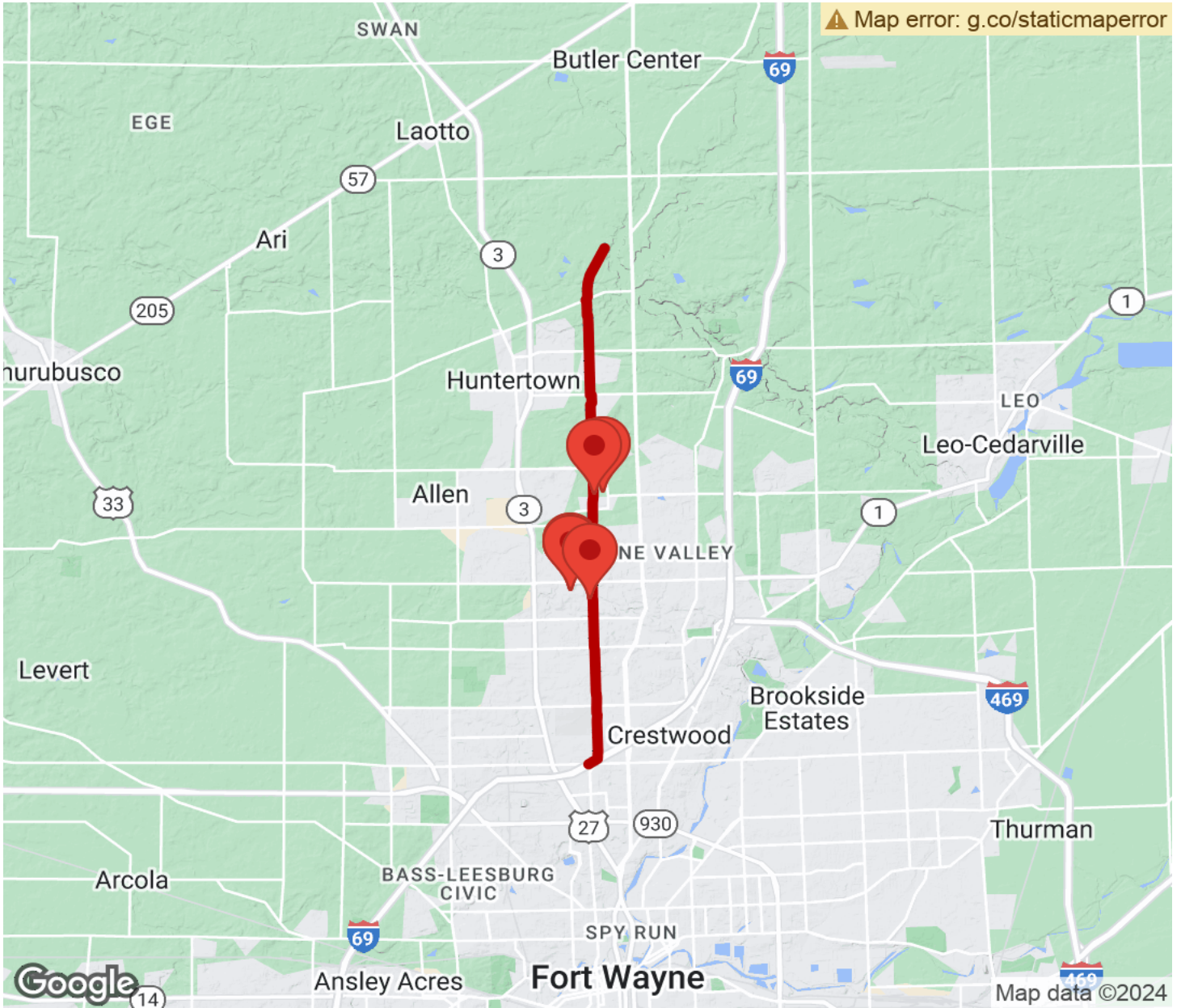
