The Clayton Riverwalk is a paved, 10-foot-wide, four-mile route along the tree-lined Neuse River in the Town of Clayton, about 20 miles southeast of Raleigh. It connects directly to the [Neuse River Trail](#), which runs along the eastern outskirts of Raleigh for nearly 30 miles, and links to the beautiful [Sam's Branch Greenway](#). The riverwalk is also part of two long-distance trail networks: the East Coast Greenway and the Mountains-to-Sea Trail.

In May 2023, the replacement of three bridges along the Clayton Riverwalk was completed and the bridges opened to the public.

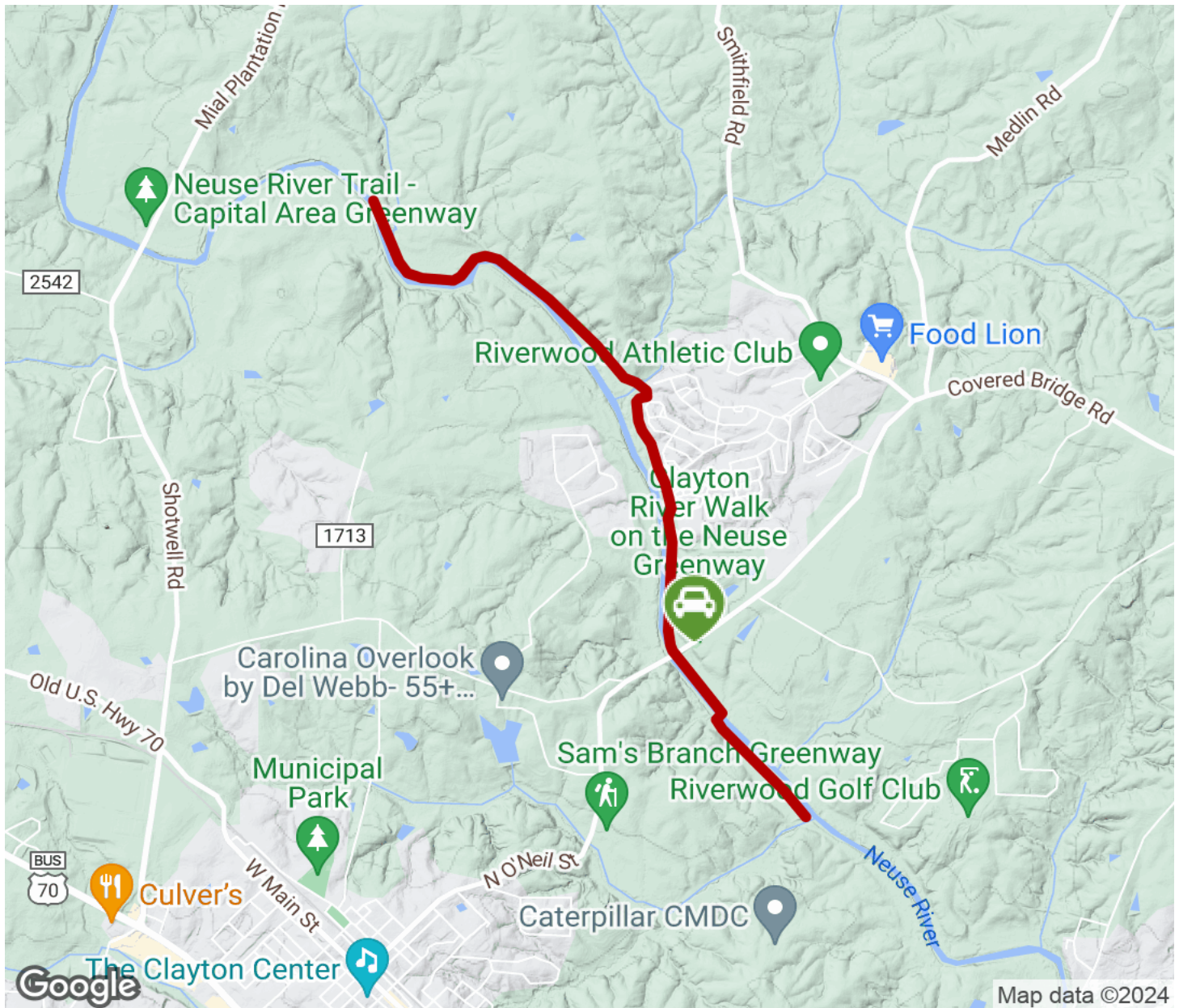
Parking & Trail Access
