






Erie Attica Trail New York

The Erie Attica Trail lies in the Finger Lakes region of New York along the former railroad for which it's named. A glimpse of this past can be seen in the beautiful truss bridge that spans 220 feet across the Genesee River.

The wooded rail-trail begins on the west end of Avon and continues west just over a mile to the <u>Genesee Valley</u> <u>Greenway</u>, which heads all the way north to Rochester. One day, the rail-trail will extend a bit farther west to River Road.
