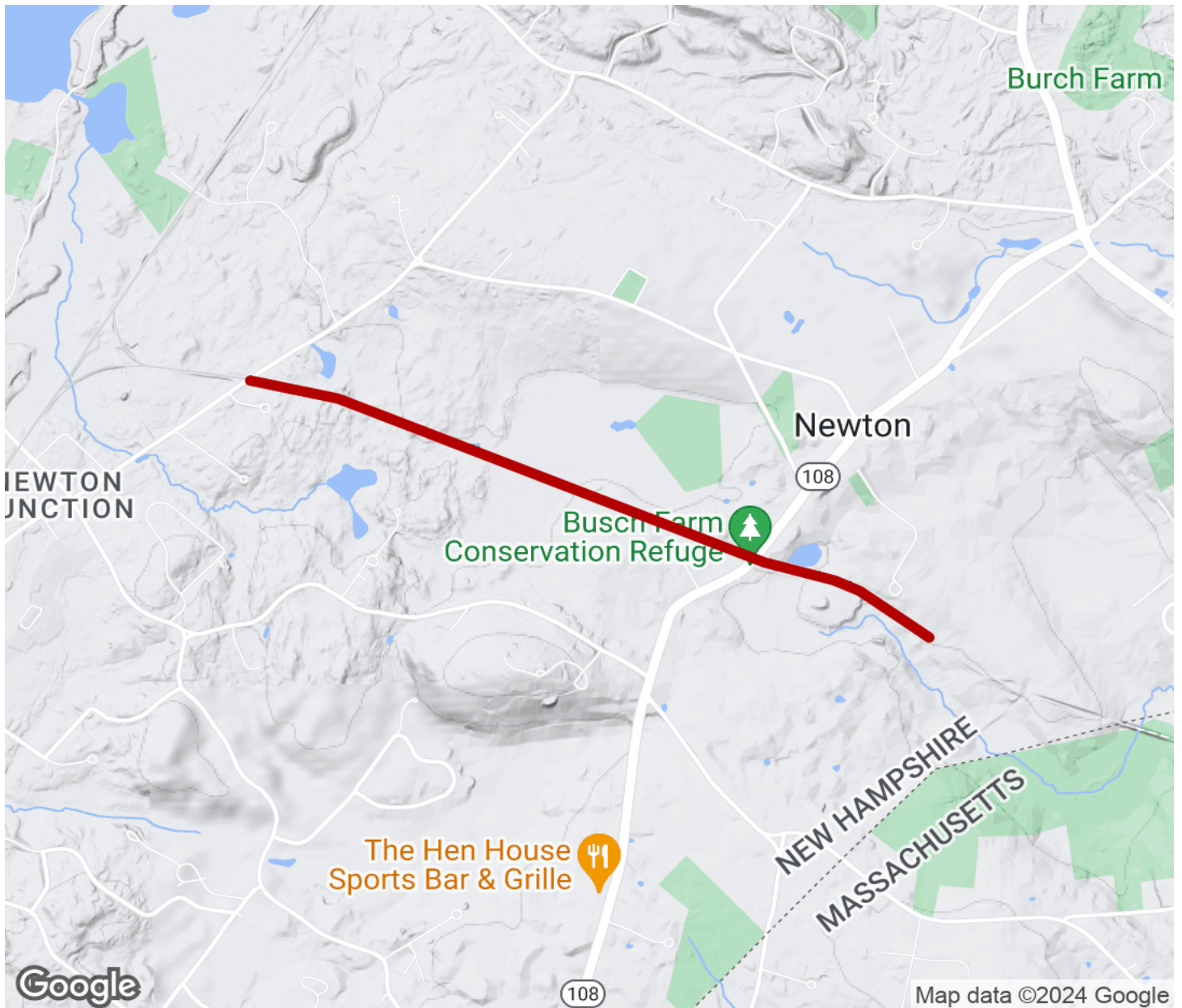
Parking & Trail Access
