You can encounter numerous wildlife such as owls, river otters, orioles, and eagles. Amenities such as picnic tables, restrooms, water, and fishing are also available. While you are enjoying the trail you can also take in sights of Mt. Baker, Rainier and the Cascades.

A few streets north of the Lowell Riverfront Trail beginning on Everett and Grand Ave., you can take the a historic tour of the old industrial Everett waterfront via the Mill Town Trail.

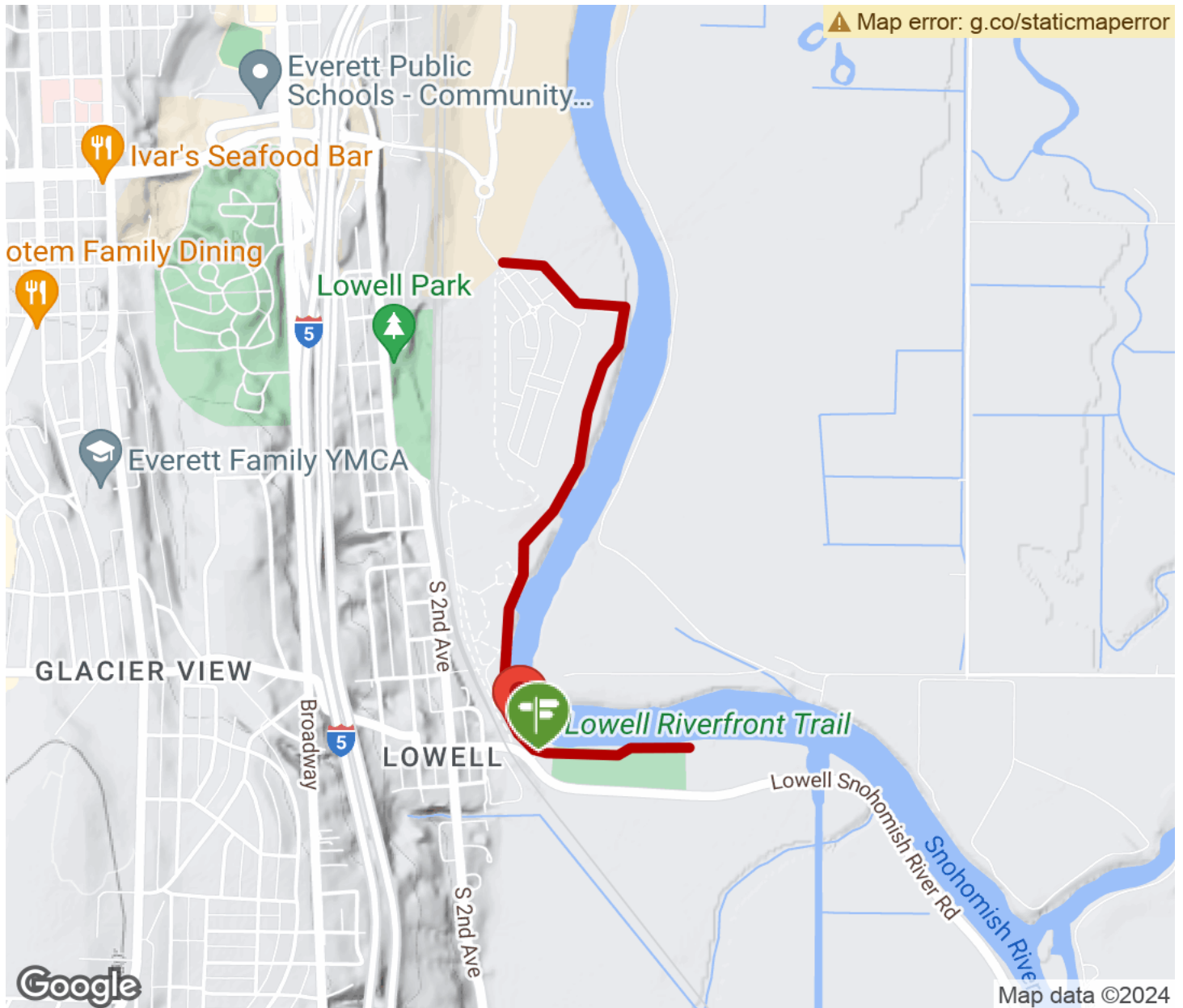
Parking & Trail Access

Turn right (south) onto Lowell Road/3rd Ave. Drive 1.9 miles. Turn left (east) onto Lenora St. Drive 0.2 mile to Lowell Riverfront Trail parking area. Handicap Accessible
