Riverwalk Trail (KS)

Kansas

Located in Junction City (about two hours west of Kansas City), the Riverwalk Trail winds along the north bank of the Republican River



Located in Junction City (about two hours west of Kansas City), the Riverwalk Trail winds along the north bank of the Republican River for nearly five miles between Fort Riley and Milford Dam. The crushed-limestone trail connects to the Milford State Park trail system via the Old River Bluff Trail, making for a continuous 14-mile ride. Along the way, look for bald eagles perched in the treetops.

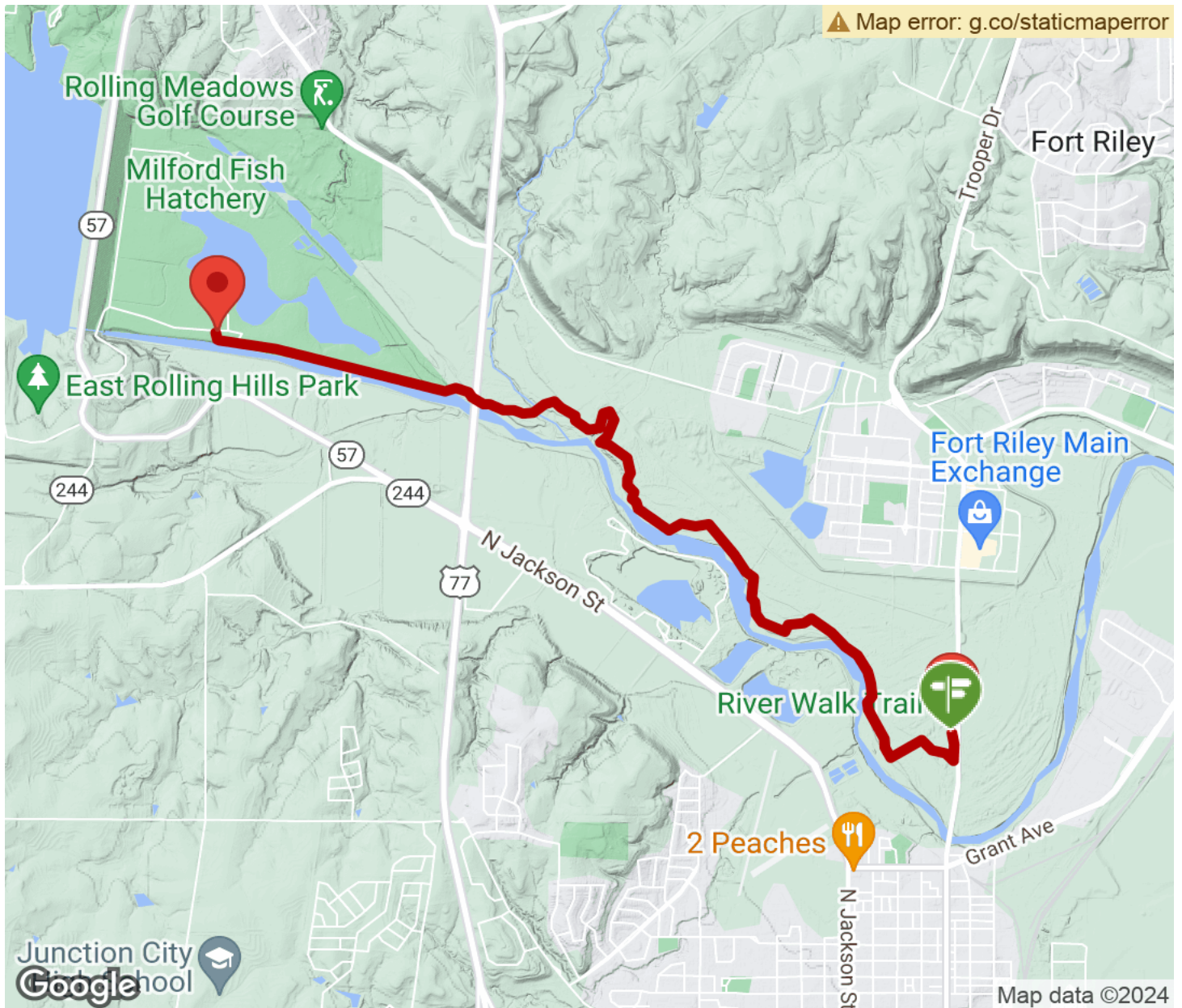
Parking & Trail Access
