Springdale's Powell Street Trail runs along its namesake road for more than 2 miles, offering an important trail connection to

Springdale's Powell Street Trail runs along its namesake road for more than 2 miles, offering an important trail connection to Fayetteville for the community's residents. While most of the trail is off-road, two short stretches are a combination of sidewalk and protected bike lanes.

The trail feeds into Lake Fayetteville Park at its southern end, where trail users can pick up the popular [Lake Fayetteville Trail](#) for a trip around the scenic lake. In the north, the Powell Street Trail leads to the short [Park Street Trail](#), which itself links to the longer [Spring Creek Trail](#) after just a few blocks.

All four trails are also components of the [Razorback Regional Greenway](#), a 46-mile, primarily off-road, shared-use trail that extends from southeast Bella Vista to the

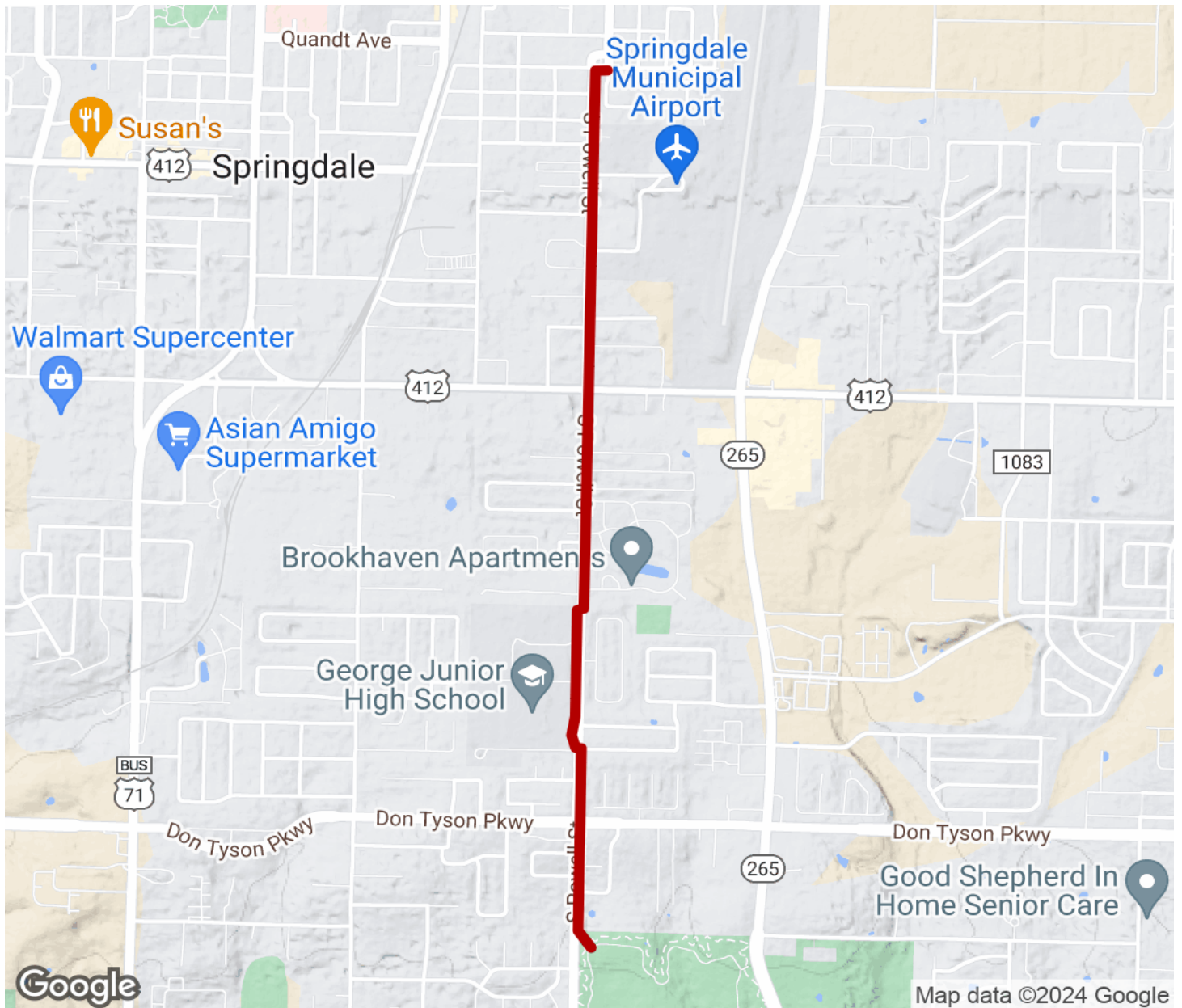
Parking & Trail Access
