The South Fork New River Greenway offers a winding, paved pathway through the town of Boone, nestled in the Blue Ridge



The South Fork New River Greenway offers a winding, paved pathway through the town of Boone, nestled in the Blue Ridge Mountains of North Carolina. Brookshire Park is at the northern end of the trail and Watauga High School is at the southern end. Midway, the nearly 2-mile trail heads under U.S. 421, providing a safe and convenient route for students to get from school to the park, where they can play tennis or soccer, or simply enjoy the open fields.

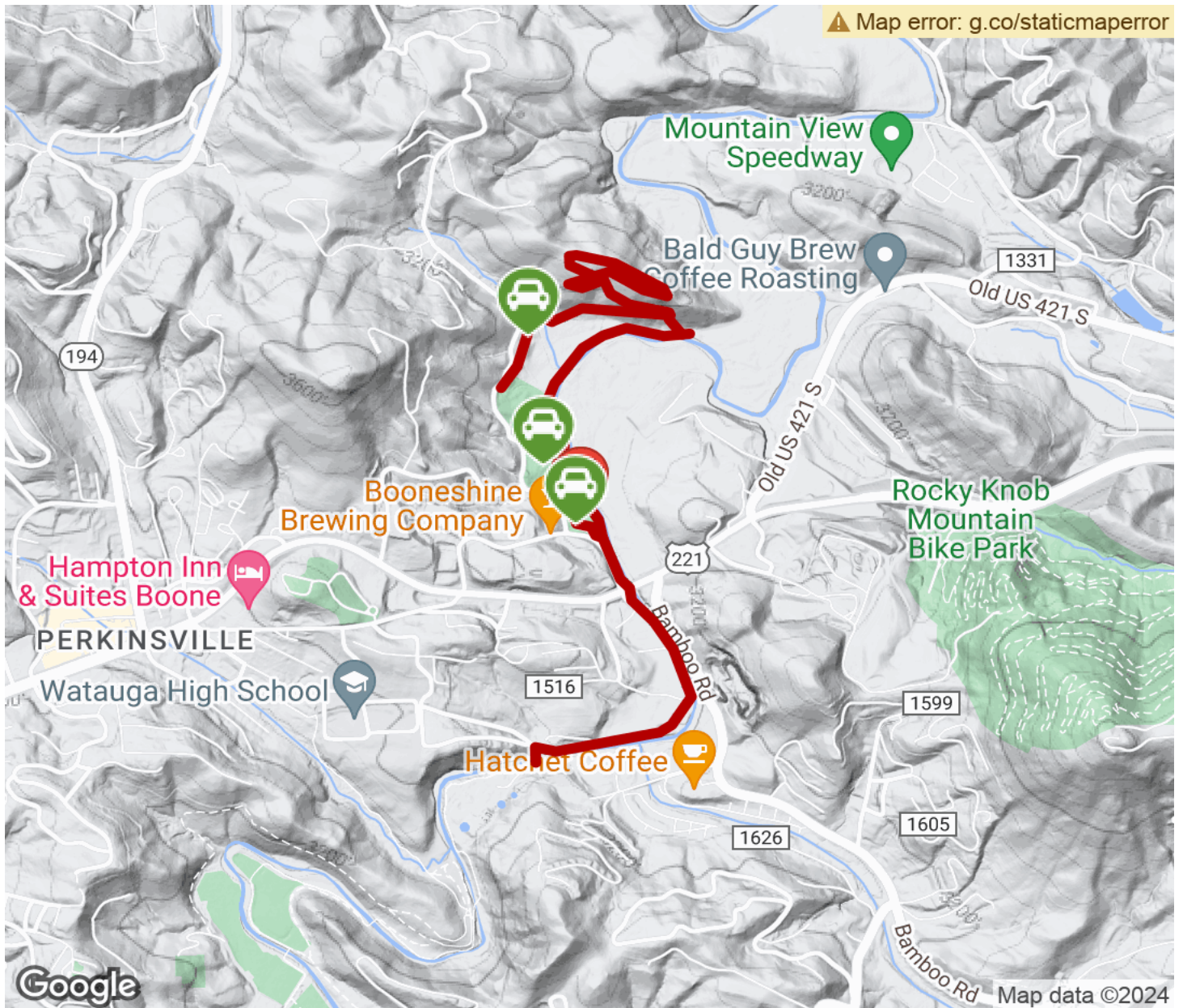
Parking & Trail Access
