The Towler Road Spur is a short but pleasant route in the trail hub of Xenia, Ohio. Although the paved pathway parallels the roadway, it's separated from traffic by a wide grassy median dotted with trees,



The Towler Road Spur is a short but pleasant route in the trail hub of Xenia, Ohio. Although the paved pathway parallels the roadway, it's separated from traffic by a wide grassy median dotted with trees.

On its eastern end, it connects to the 15-mile [Creekside Trail](#), which heads towards Dayton. At this juncture, you can also enter Sol Arnovitz Park, which—at 21 acres—is Xenia's largest city park and includes an 18-hole disc golf course and hiking trails. On its western end, the trail takes travelers to James Ranch Park, featuring a restored 19th-century farm house and gardens.

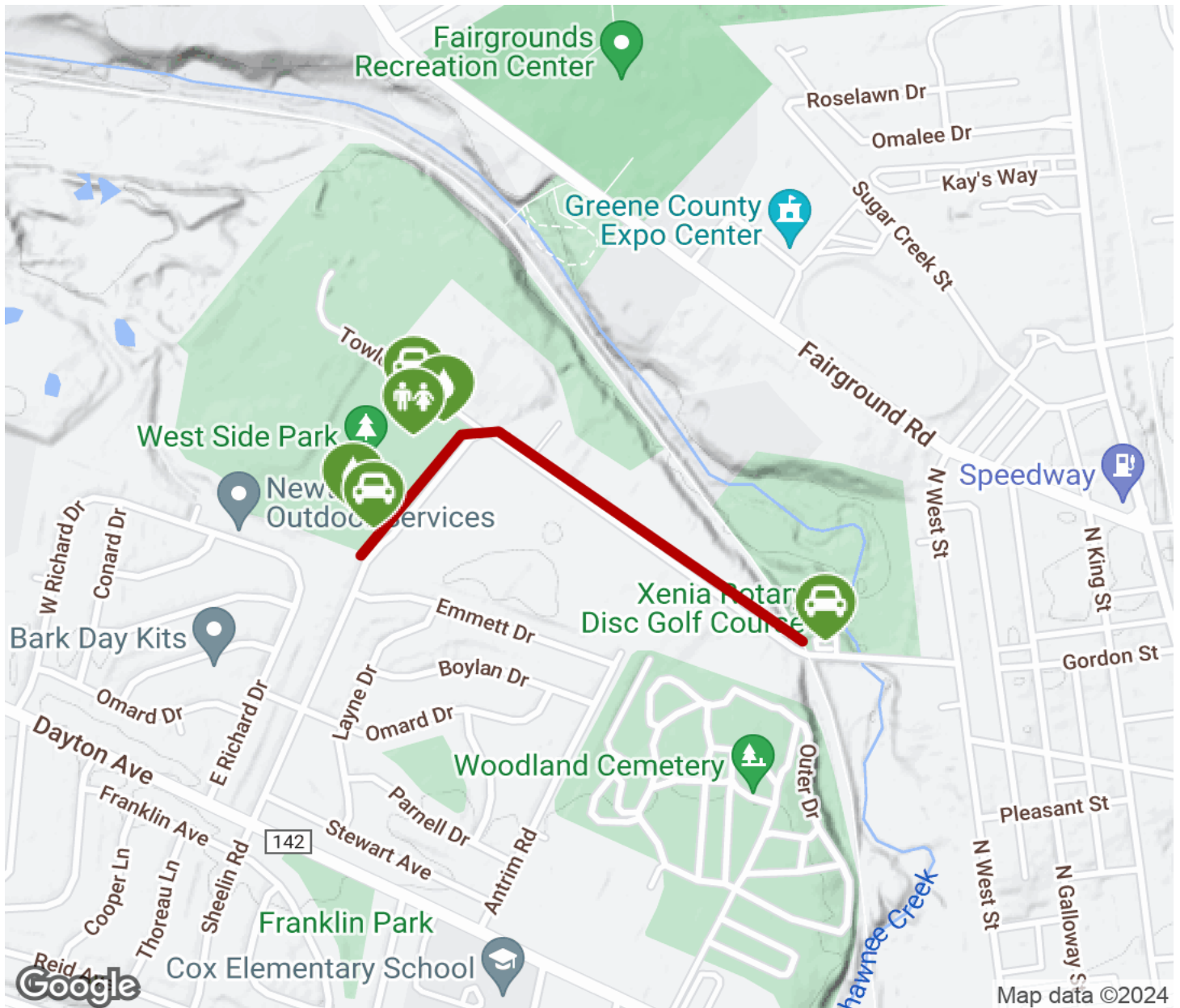
Parking & Trail Access
