The Walnut Creek Trail serves as an important trail connector in West Des Moines. On its northern end, it seamlessly links to the [Clive Greenbelt Trail](#), which heads west and, in turn, connects to the [Raccoon River Valley Trail](#), which spans a whopping 80+ miles. At this end of the trail, the Walnut Creek Trail also provides access to Colby Park, a signature recreational amenity for the City of Windsor Heights, where you'll find a community center, pavilion, ball fields, and a playground.

From the park, the paved pathway winds through a wooded residential area. At its southern end, the Walnut Creek Trail connects to the Bill Riley Trail, which ties into Des Moines' expansive trail network.

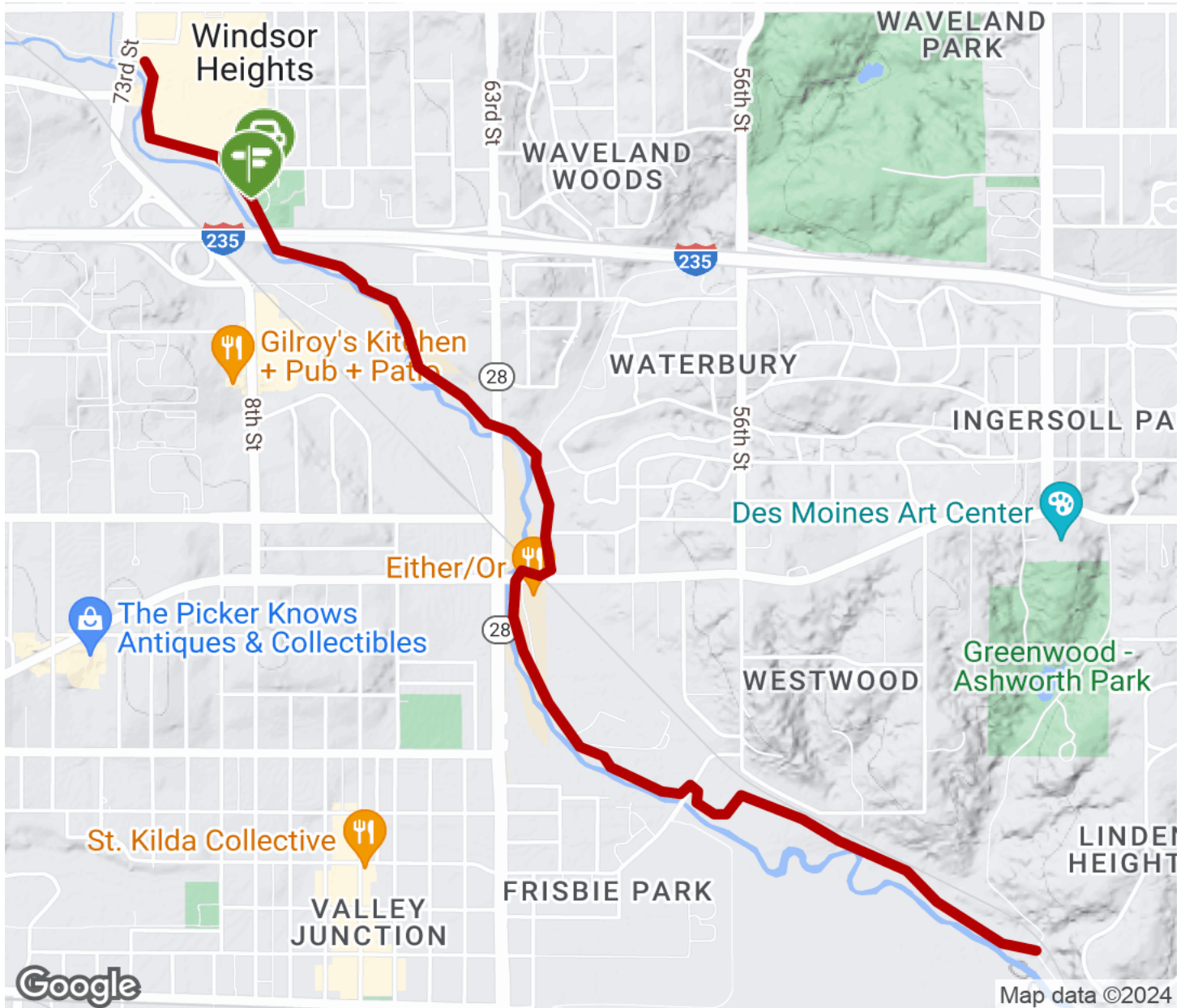
Parking & Trail Access
