Roseville's Dry Creek Greenway is planned to one day span 4.25 miles through the southern neighborhoods of this central



Roseville's Dry Creek Greenway is planned to one day span 4.25 miles through the southern neighborhoods of this central California town. Currently, just shy of a mile of the paved pathway has been constructed along Linda Creek. This segment is referred to as the Sierra Gardens Multi-use Path and follows the wooded waterway through a residential area. An offshoot from the main spine leads to Sierra Gardens Park, which offers a plethora of athletic facilities.

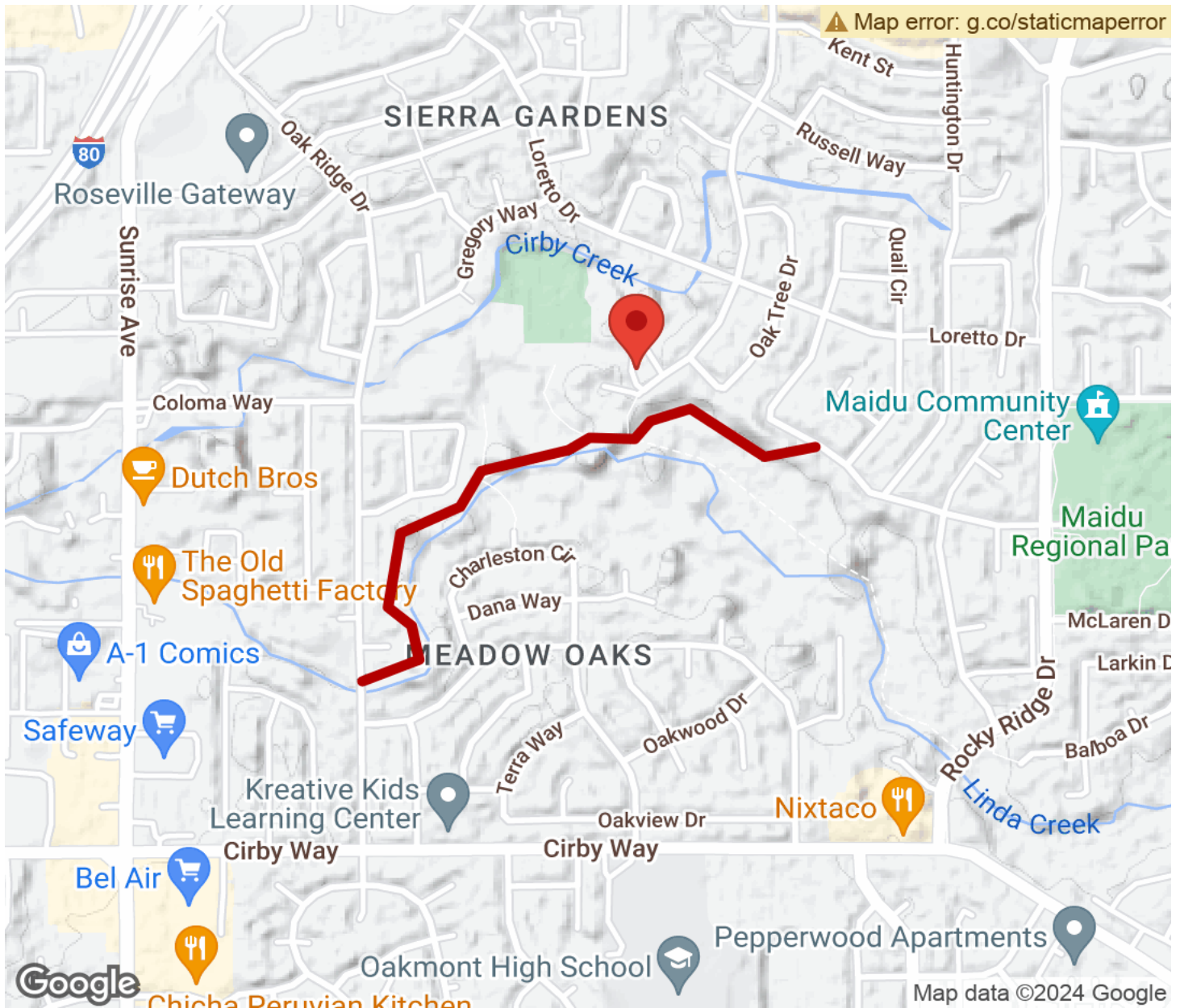
