The trail isn't particularly exciting on its own, but it does act as a spine to which other trails connect, including Long Lake Regional Park, Lexington Parkway Regional Trail, Birch Lake Regional Trail and the Bruce Vento Regional Trail.

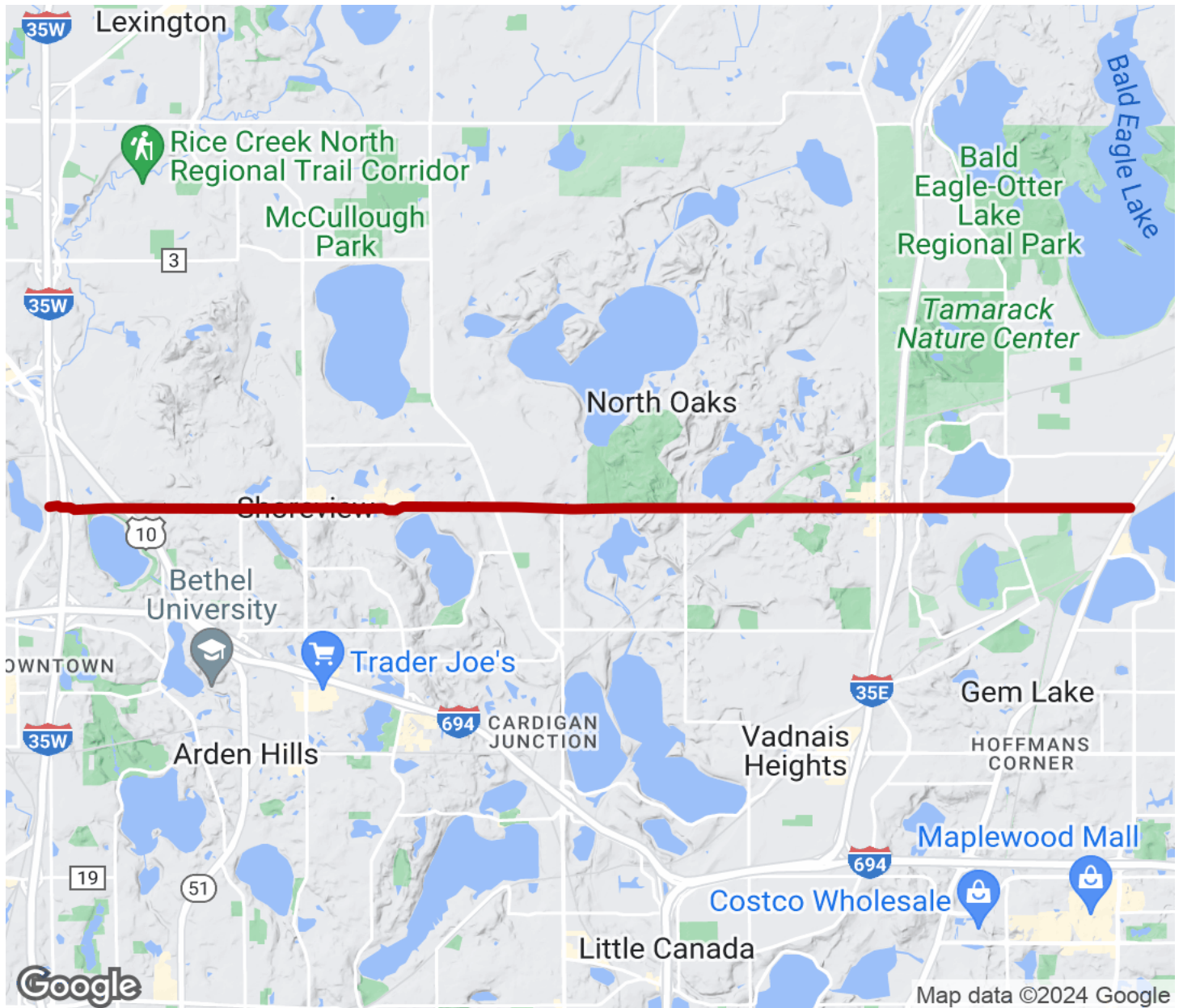
